7 **Abstract:**

1 During the period of 11-15 May 2009, 3GPP2 TSG-S meetings were held at the Vancouver Marriott
2 Pinnacle Downtown Hotel in Vancouver, BC, Canada. This document is intended to summarize those

5 **OPENING PLENARY**

- 21 architecture (MSCe based one) in the currently published version. The following
- 22 issues were identified:
- 23 • There will be some impact on the existing architecture. SNSF will have to
- 24 contain both signaling and bearer (media).
- 25 • It was acknowledged that deployment is eased with IP transport, as
- 26 pointed out in the WI description.
- 27 • There was some discussion on implementation issues, but it was decided
- 28 that this is best deferred for TSG-A, where technical specifications are to
- 29 be developed.
- 30 • Regarding mixed mode (both MSC and MSCe belonging to a pool),
- 31 Huawei expressed that it was not their intention to propose that, but it
- 32 could potentially be feasible.
- 33 • Motivation for this feature extension is similar to the LMSD architecture
- 34 based one. The main benefit is load balancing and load re-distribution.
