26 The Implementation Strategies for the 3GPP2 Vision Document were presented in -009. In addition to
27 the decisions and action items recorded below, it was also noted:

32 **Action SC 2009/05-01**

33 TSG-S is to implement an annual update process for the Vision document. Details of this process will
34 be announced shortly.
35

36 **Action SC 2009/05-02**

37 The 3GPP2 Secretariat will work with the Vision ad hoc Chair to draft correspondence that will be
38 forwarded to the 3GPP2 MRPs, along with the Vision document, soliciting operator and other
39 industry comments. Future revisions/versions of the Vision document will take these comments into
40 consideration. This correspondence will be submitted to the TSG-S Newport Beach plenary for
41 review and approval.

1
2 **Action SC 2009/05-03**

3 Following the approval of the correspondence noted in action SC 2009/05-02, the 3GPP2 Secretariat
4 will forward the correspondence and the Vision document to the 3GPP2 MRPs for comment.
5 Comments will be returned to the Secretariat and forwarded to the Vision ad hoc, following a 30-day
6 review by the MRPs.

7
8 **Action SC 2009/05-04**

9 The Secretariat will work with the CDG to draft a Press Release announcing the availability of
10 SC.R5003-0 v1.0. The previously approved process for approving and distributing 3GPP2 press
11 releases will be followed.

12
13 **Decision SC 2009/05-02**

32 The modified 2010 3GPP2 Meeting Calendar was presented in -010.

33
34 Contribution -019, which contained the conflicts identified during the calendar review process and
35 were subsequently taken into account when modifying the 2010 calendar, was presented FYI.

37 **Decision SC 2009/05-03**

38 The Steering Committee approves the modified 2010 Meeting Calendar presented in SC-20090528-
39 010.

40
41 **Decision SC 2009/05-04**

42 The 3GPP2 Secretariat may begin planning the 2Q2010 meetings.

43
44 **Action SC 2009/05-06**

45 With regards to the 3GPP2 meetings to be held in China during 2010, CCSA is to notify the Meeting
46 Planning Review Team (prior to the end of June 2009):

- 1 1. If the CCSA-hosted meetings will occur in April 2010 or August 2010.
- 2 2. If CCSA will plan the China meetings directly or delegate that activity to the 3GPP2 Secretariat.

3 4 6.5 Collaborative Software Tools (SC-20090528-020)

5 Contribution -020, which contained the information on collaborative software tools, was presented. In
6 addition to the decisions and action items recorded, it was also noted:

- 7 ➤ “WebEcho” is the only collaborative online tool that will be supported by the 3GPP2 Secretariat. If
8 a tool other than WebEcho is used, no support will be available by the 3GPP2 Secretariat.
- 9 ➤ The 3GPP2 budget is only able to absorb the cost of WebEcho’s usage for TSG plenaries. If this
10 tool will be used for meetings other than at the plenary level, the cost associated must be
11 sponsored by a member company.

12 13 **Decision 2009/05-05**

14 The Secretariat will make “WebEcho” available immediately for use by 3GPP2 participants.

15 16 **Decision 2009/05-06**

17 WebEcho will only be paid for, out of the 3GPP2 budget, for TSG plenaries. All other uses of
18 WebEcho must be sponsored (i.e., paid-for) by a 3GPP2 member company.

19 20 **Action SC 2009/05-07**

21 Contribution SC-20090528-020, the Collaborative Software Tools information, is remanded to all TSGs
22 for review and comment. Comments will be forwarded to the Secretariat by the end of the July 2009
23 TSG meetings. All comments will be collated by the Secretariat and forwarded to the SC, for action as
24 appropriate.

25 26 **Action SC 2009/05-08**

27 A demonstration of the WebEcho software will be given to the TSG Chairs and Vice-Chairs during
28 the July 2009 meetings in Seoul, Korea. Written instructions on the use of WebEcho, for all other
29 3GPP2 participants, will be provided by the Secretariat by the July 2009 meetings in Seoul, Korea.

30 31 6.6 3GPP2 Workshop (SC-20090528-021)

32 The SC-approved 3GPP2 Workshop Recommendations were presented in -021, as FYI. The comment
33 submitted during the SC review process, noting that funding should come exclusively from
34 sponsoring companies, was provided in -021a. It was noted that sufficient sponsorship funding
35 commitments have been secured.

36 37 **7. New Business**

39 Contribution -022, which contains a proposal to include Femto work items in Release 6, was
40 presented.

41
42 It was noted that because 3GPP2 release timelines are driven by the development schedule of a
43 release’s critical work items, the timeframe information provided in this contribution is no longer
44 valid. Release 6 is currently scheduled to be available July 2010.

45 46 **Decision SC 2009/05-07**

1 The SC approves the “flagging” of Femto work items (3GPP2-00189 “3GPP2 System Enhancements
2 for Femto and Pico Cell Support” and 3GPP2-00215 “Femto Security Framework”) as critical to
3 Release 6. The TSG-S PMT will continue monitoring the Release 6 schedule and communicate with
4 the SC, as needed.
5

6 7.2 UMB Trademark Guidelines (SC-20090528-023)

7 Contribution -023, which contains a request for formalization of the UMB trademark, was presented.
8 During the discussions, it was noted that the SC approved SC-20070115-009d, which contains the
9 language to be used when referencing “Ultra Mobile Broadband™” or “UMB™”.
10

12 Contribution SC-20070115-009d, which contains the SC-approved language to be used when “Ultra
13 Mobile Broadband” or “UMB” is referenced in a 3GPP2 specification, is remanded to the TSGs for
14 immediate implementation.
15

17 Contribution SC-20070115-009d will be forwarded to the Organization Partners with the
18 recommendation that the UMB trademark guidelines be remanded to the WPD ad hoc for inclusion
19 in the 3GPP2 Drafting Rules.

8 11.3 TSG-S (SC-20090528-007)

9 TSG-S presented its report to the SC in contribution -007. There were no comments or questions for
10 clarification.
11

12 11.4 TSG-X (SC-20090528-006)

13 TSG-X presented its report to the SC in contribution -006. While there were no comments or questions
14 for clarification, TSG-X is requesting action by the SC:
15

16 *Joint Femto Discussion in March and May Meetings*

17 TSG-X took action items to report back to the SC on the plans for 3GPP2 working with the Broadband
18 Forum (BBF) as well as the inter-TSG working relationships to support data object model
19 management. Two all-TSG Femto discussions were held during the supermeetings in New Orleans
20 and Vancouver. The respective meeting reports are attachments C and D, provided for information.
21 The SC should note that a cross-TSG ad hoc, the 3GPP2 Femto ad hoc, has been created. Among other
22 responsibilities, this ad hoc will be presenting the 3GPP2 secretariat and SC/OP with a proposal for
23 establishing a working relationship with the BBF to publish the 3GPP2 Femto data object models.
24 TSG-X will provide plenary oversight for the ad hoc.
25

26 TSG-X requests the SC to support the establishment of this relationship with BBF and to encourage
27 the OPs to also support the relationship. It is our understanding, based on an email exchange
28 between Vicky Mitchell and her counterpart in BBF that a formal agreement on the working logistics
29 will need to be agreed by both parties prior to any actual work commencing.
30

31 **Decision SC 2009/05-09**

32 The SC approves the pursuit of a 3GPP2/Broadband Forum relationship that encourages the
33 sharing of content between the organizations.
34

35 **Action SC 2009/05-13**

36 The 3GPP2 Secretariat will contact the BBF to secure a formal agreement on the working logistics
37 that will need to be codified prior to any actual work commencing.
38

39 *Request for 3GPP2 Femto Presentation at London Femtocell World Summit*

40 In discussions following the all-TSG Femto discussion with Simon Saunders in March, Simon
41 requested that 3GPP2 once again provide a presentation on our Femto work at the London Femtocell
42 World Summit. TSG-X recommends that 3GPP2 respond positively to this request. TSG-X will follow
43 up with Simon to determine the appropriate material to include for this forum.
44

45 TSG-X requests the SC to endorse the concept of a 3GPP2 presentation and support an email
46 approval of the presentation prior to the Summit.

1
2 **Decision SC 2009/05-10**

3 The SC approves 3GPP2's participation in the London Femtocell World Summit and thanks Mr.
4 Doug Knisely, Airvana, for volunteering to present at the Summit.
5

6 **Action SC 2009/05-14**

7 The 3GPP2 Secretariat will forward the presentation to be given at the London Femtocell World
8 Summit by Mr. Doug Knisely, Airvana, to the Steering Committee for approval.
9

10 *Increasing 3GPP2 Femto Work Visibility*

11 In addition to his request for 3GPP2 to participate in the London Femtocell World Summit, Simon
12 Saunders requested 3GPP2 to consider other opportunities to increase the visibility of 3GPP2s work
13 on Femto. He noted in discussion his observation that in general, industry is far more familiar with
14 the Femto work of 3GPP, even though 3GPP2 has several advantages in the field. Opportunities to
15 increase the visibility of our work include attendance and participation in Femto conferences, press
16 releases, and submissions to industry magazines. Simon indicated his willingness to have Femto
17 Forum work with 3GPP2 on any or all of these approaches, as well as being open to considering other
18 means.
19

20 TSG-X requests the SC to consider the opportunities to increase the visibility of our work and
21 establish a plan, potentially with Femto Forum, to engage in publicizing the results of our work.
22

23 **Decision SC 2009/05-11**

24 The SC approves working with the Femto Forum to increase the visibility of 3GPP2's efforts,
25 noting that the SC will approve those efforts on a project-by-project basis.
26

27 *TSG-X Tech Writer Funding*

28 The tech writer used by TSG-X has informed us that he does not have sufficient hours remaining to
29 complete X.P0011-E. Two parts, 005 and 006, remain to be worked. At beginning of 2009, the 3GPP2
30 secretariat had indicated that tech writer funds unused in TSGC and/or TSG-S may be made
31 available for TSG-X to complete this work.
32

33 TSG-X requests that the tech writer funds not being used in the other TSGs be re-allocated for use in
34 TSG-X.
35

36 **Action SC 2009/05-15**

37 Additional information must be gathered before a decision can be made with regards to TSG-X's
38 request for additional technical writer funding:

- 39 1. The SC Chair will work with the TSG Chairs to determine the status of future technical writer
40 needs organizational-wide (TSG future needs, where the funds are currently allocated, etc.).
- 41 2. The 3GPP2 Secretariat will contact the OP Finance Committee to determine the availability of
42 technical writer funds.
- 43 3. Once available, the SC will be provided the information gathered above and make a formal
44 decision on the re-allocation of technical writer funds for use by TSG-X.
45

47 The current activities being managed by the TSG-S PMT group were summarized and presented in
