37 Noting that the official Terms of Reference for TSG-A and TSG-X will not change, the IP Service
38 development falls within the scope of TSG-X; however, coordination with TSG-A (or others) may be
39 necessary and can proceed (without additional SC approval) as needed.

41 7.5 SC.R1005-A v1.0 - Drafting Rules Document Approval (SC-20100308-025)

42 Section 1.1 of contribution -008, the section of the TSG-S PMT report that recommends the SC
43 approve and publish SC.R1005-A v1.0 (3GPP2 Drafting Rules), was discussed. During the discussions
44 it was noted that one outstanding issue, the use of normative language in a 3GPP2 report, remains.
45

46 Resolution of this topic will begin at the April 2010 meetings in Xian, China with the goal to address

1 this outstanding issue and codify the requirements as soon as possible. Correspondence SC-20100308-
2 008c notes this outstanding issue and asks for additional information from each OP on their
3 respective procedures to help guide the discussions.

44 ➤ TSG-S has received contributions for work item and Stage 1 for ECCB. The current drafts have

1 restricted the scope of the work such that only TSG-A interfaces will be affected. TSG-S
2 requests that the SC seek approval from the OPs for this narrowly-scoped regional
3 requirement.

4
5 **Action SC 2010/03-18**

6 The SC Chair will seek approval from the OPs allowing TSG-S to develop the work item and Stage 1
7 for ECCB.
8

9 11.4 TSG-X (SC-20100308-006)

10 Contribution -006, the TSG-X report to the SC, was presented. While there were no questions for
11 clarification, the following actions were requested by the SC:
12

13 **M2M Numbering**

14 It has been noted that 3GPP is investigating alternative numbering schemes for M2M devices. The
15 proliferation of M2M devices will exhaust numbers much faster than traditional telecom devices
16 alone.
17

18 TSG-X recommended that it is imperative that any investigation of a numbering scheme for M2M
19 devices be a coordinated, global effort. TSG-X requests the SC to support a decision to coordinate
20 investigation of a new numbering scheme for CDMA M2M devices with the 3GPP study.
21

22 **Decision SC 2010/03-11**

23 The SC supports TSG-X coordinating with the 3GPP study to investigate a new numbering scheme
24 for CDMA M2M devices.
25

26 **Callback to an Emergency Call Origination**

27 A new WI has recently been introduced for Emergency Call Callback. It has been identified as a
28 regional-only feature, and as such TSG-X is notifying the SC, as we have been instructed to do in
29 the past, for a decision on whether or not to develop this capability in 3GPP2. It has been noted
30 that the feature has potential impact across all TSGs, but the regions intending to use the
31 capability are only asking to standardize the portion under the scope of TSG-A; proprietary
32 solutions will be used across the air interface and core network.
33

34 At the Chair's meeting in Bangkok, it was agreed to document both the regional nature of the
35 work and the limitation of the standards impact to the A-interface. If this is done, TSG-X has no
36 objection to developing the regional support in 3GPP2.
37

38 However, it has also been noted that if complete end-to-end standardization is required, the
39 necessary support will severely and negatively impact the core network in regions where there
40 are in fact no plans to implement the capability. Therefore, TSG-X would have strong concerns
41 about supporting development of this regional capability in 3GPP2.
42

43 TSG-X requests the SC to make a decision on proceeding with this regional regulatory WI in
44 3GPP2 as a very limited project impacting only the A-interface specifications.
45

46 **Decision SC 2010/03-12**

47 The SC supports the development of the Emergency Call-Back regional regulatory work item as a

1 very limited project impacting only the A-interface specifications.

2
3 **Action SC 2010/03-19**

4 The SC Chair will ask the OPs to approve the development of the Emergency Call-Back regional
5 regulatory requirement on a limited scope (as identified in the TSG-X report to the SC).
6

7 **ITU-T SG2 on Message Identifiers**

8 TSG-X sent correspondence to the SC out of the January meeting requesting the SC Chair to
9 convey to the OPs a request for support in ITU-T SG2 on the issue of Message Identifiers. ITU-T
10 SG2 has been communicating with the SDOs for over two years, trying to find a role they can play
11 in assigning Message Identifiers. The SDOs have been responding that indeed 3GPP2, 3GPP, and
12 their associated SDOs have the matter well in hand. In December ITU-T SG2 sent liaisons to
13 3GPP2 and 3GPP, again trying to find room for them to take action. 3GPP has already responded.
14 A 3GPP2 response is provided as Attachment E.

15
16 TSG-X requests the SC Chair to include this correspondence in communication to the OPs,
17 requesting their active support in working with their representation in ITU-T SG2 to help reach
18 closure on this matter.
19
