Documents 3GPP2- A00-20040920-018 – *3GPP2 A.S0006 V&V Comments Form* and A00-20040920-018 – *3GPP2 A.S0006 v0.5 Interoperability Specification (IOS) for Hybrid MS/AT (HAT) Authentication* were presented.
