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2 Approved Summary of 3GPP2 TSG-C Meetings for 15-19 January 2001 in San Diego, CA

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8 **Abstract:**

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9 This document is a summary of the 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings which were held during the period  
10 15-19 January 2001 in San Diego, CA.

11 **Recommendation:**

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12 Review and adopt.

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14 **Notice:**

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1 During the period of 15-19 January 2001, meetings of 3GPP2 TSG-C were held at the Hilton San  
2 Diego Mission Valley Hotel in San Diego, CA. This document is intended to summarize those  
3 proceedings.

5 **OPENING PLENARY**

6 1. **CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS:** The meeting was called to order at  
7 10:00 AM local time on 15 January 2001 by TSG-C Chair, Jean Alphonse (Lucent).

8 The Chair advised that, based on requests from the SC Chair and some of the SDOs, the  
9 election of TSG leadership for the next term had been postponed until the closing Plenary. That  
10 closing Plenary will start at 7:30 AM on 19 January 2001.

11 He defined the priorities for this week to include the following:

- 12 • Release B V&V
- 13 • RSPC update
- 14 • Position Determination Services Addendum
- 15 • Year 2001 workplan
- 16 • Review of TSG Terms of Reference with respect to activation of All IP activities based  
17 on SC remand. This task was remanded to WG1 for action by closing Plenary.

18 2. **ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL:** A roll call of companies indicated  
19 that 33 companies included on the list of 40 active members were present and thus quorum was  
20 established (83% participation).

21 3. **INTRODUCTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS:** Contributions were  
22 loaded onto the 3GPP2 server and listed in the document register (C00-20010115-000). The  
23 Secretary noted that contribution C00-20010115-006 had been previously presented in  
24 TR45.5 and liaised to TSG-C. As such, it would not be re-presented in this Plenary..

25 4. **AGENDA APPROVAL:** The proposed agenda (C00-20010115-001R1) was presented and  
26 approved without objection with the modification that contribution 15 was listed under agenda  
27 item 10h.

28 5. **ELECTION OF CHAIRMANSHIP:** Elections deferred until closing Plenary. No additional  
29 statements of candidacy were announced at this time other than those of the incumbent Chair  
30 and Vice Chairs.

31 6. **ASSIGNMENTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO AGENDA ITEMS:** Contributions were  
32 assigned to agenda items.

33 7. **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY:** The summary for the December  
34 meeting in Kauai, HI (C00-20010115-002) was presented and approved without objection as  
35 submitted.

1 The summary of the interim Plenary conference call of 5 January 2001 (C00-20010115-003)  
2 was presented and approved without objection as submitted.

3 8. CORRESPONDENCE:

- 4 • E-mail correspondence dated 5 January 2001 from Samsung noting the candidacy of  
5 TSG-C Vice Chair, Sang Uoon Chung (Samsung), for the position of TSG-C Vice  
6 Chair for the next term (C0020010115-004) was presented as FYI.
- 7 • Correspondence dated 3 January 2001 stating the support of Lucent Technologies for  
8 the candidacy of Jean Alphonse for the position of TSG-C Chair for the next term  
9 (C00-20010115-005) was presented as FYI.
- 10 • Undated correspondence from ETSI SCP in response to previous TSG-C  
11 correspondence (C00-20010115-007) was presented. This correspondence was  
12 remanded to WG1 for review and action as appropriate by the closing Plenary.
- 13 • Correspondence dated 15 December 2001 to TSG-S from TSG-N regarding  
14 1xEV-DO support (C00-20010115-008) was presented as FYI.
- 15 • Correspondence dated 15 December 2001 to the 3GPP2 SC Chair from TSG-N  
16 regarding UIM ID (C00-20010115-009) was presented as FYI.
- 17 • An overview of the CDG IOTA Team (C00-20010115-010) was presented as FYI.
- 18 • The CDG IOTA-HCM Stage 3 document (C00-20010115-011) was also presented  
19 with a request for review and comment by 16 February 2001. This Stage 3 document  
20 was remanded to WG1 and WG2 for review and comment by the closing Plenary in  
21 Phoenix, AZ.
- 22 • A proposal to revise the C.S0008 MC-MAP specification (C00-20010115-012) was  
23 presented by QUALCOMM. This proposal noted that the current MC-MAP  
24 specification does not address the integration of packet data services from a  
25 GSM/UMTS/GPRS core network and recommended that this deficiency be addressed  
26 by TSG-C. This contribution was remanded to WG1 for inclusion in the year 2001  
27 workplan. The issue of which TSG-C group would be assigned to actually do this  
28 work in addition to any other items of maintenance required for both MC-MAP and  
29 DS-41 specifications was retained for consideration by the Chair.
- 30 • A letter of endorsement of TSG-C Vice Chair, Kazuto Miyazaki (Motorola-Japan), as  
31 TSG-C Vice Chair for the next term (C00-20010115-014) was noted as FYI.

1 9. LIAISON REPORT: None.

2 10. OLD BUSINESS

3 • A contribution entitled "Unified 1xEV-DV Framework Proposal and TSG-C Evaluation  
4 Process" (C00-20010115-013) was presented by Lucent, QUALCOMM, and  
5 Samsung. This contribution indicated that Lucent, QUALCOMM, and Samsung were  
6 consolidating their three (3) independent proposals into a single framework proposal  
7 from the three (3) companies. This document was noted as FYI.

8 • A contribution entitled "V&V Requirements" (C00-20010115-015) was presented by  
9 the V&V Chair, John Gabor (SiRF) with additional comments by the V&V Vice Chair,  
10 Geoffrey Cheadle (LinkAir). The V&V Chair proposed specific changes to the TSG-C  
11 V&V process (C00-20010115-015A) which were reviewed in detail by the TSG.  
12 These changes were approved without objection as modified by the discussion (C00-  
13 20010115-015AR1). Based on this approval:

- 14 • A new TSG-C WG for V&V was formed and John Gabor (SiRF  
15 Technologies) was named as the WG Chair.
- 16 • The TSG-C Terms of Reference were directed to be modified to include V&V  
17 as a mandatory requirement of the specification development process.
- 18 • The V&V of the Release B documents was scheduled to begin that afternoon,  
19 starting with C.P0005-B. The completion of all Release B documents was  
20 requested by the closing Plenary but could not be confirmed by the V&V Chair  
21 at that time.

22 11. NEW BUSINESS: None.

23 This session was recessed on 15 January 2001 at 11:45 AM local time.

24

## 25 INTERIM PLENARY

26 The meeting was reconvened on 18 January 2001 at 6:10 PM local time.

27 Quorum had been established at the opening Plenary and was not challenged. An additional six (6)  
28 member companies were noted as present. In addition, the list of companies who were eligible to vote  
29 was noted from the quorum list by the Secretary and that list was not challenged.

30 A statement of proxy designating the vote of Bell Mobility to QWEST Communications was presented.

31 5. ELECTION OF CHAIRMANSHIP:

32 • TSG-C CHAIR:

- 33 • Frederic Leroudier (LinkAir) announced his candidacy for the position of  
34 TSG-C Chair for the next term and he presented a letter of support from his  
35 company (C00-20010115-040).

- 1 • 3GPP2 Secretariat, Henry Cuschieri, called for any additional candidates for  
2 the position of TSG-C Chair and none were noted. The Secretariat then closed  
3 the nominations for the position of Chair.
- 4 • The Secretariat advised that WPD Article 28 required that, in the case of  
5 multiple candidates for a position, a secret ballot must be held.
- 6 • LinkAir requested an interpretation of the last sentence in Article 22 in the  
7 WPD. The Secretariat indicated that the implications of the phrase “unless no  
8 other candidate is available successive Chairs, should not usually be from the  
9 same Organizational Partner, the same region, or from the same group of  
10 companies” in that sentence were unknown to him.
- 11 • The Secretariat noted that the ballot, since it was prepared in advance, included  
12 only the name of the previously announced candidate, Jean Alphonse (Lucent).  
13 He advised that to vote for any other candidate, a write-in vote was required.  
14 To cast a write-in vote, the voter must both write the name of the candidate on  
15 one (1) of the lines available for that purpose and mark the box next to it to cast  
16 the vote.
- 17 • The Secretariat also noted that any ballot not received or any ballot received  
18 but not fully executed would be considered to be an abstention.
- 19 • The Secretariat reminded the TSG of the rules of WPD Article 28 as follows:  
20 “When, in the first ballot, no candidate has obtained 71% of the votes cast, a  
21 second ballot shall be held.”
- 22 • The ballots were distributed to the voting member of each company present and  
23 eligible to vote. The submitted ballots were then collected and counted by the  
24 Secretariat. The results were indicated as follows:
- 25 • Jean Alphonse (Lucent) 23  
26 • Frederic Leroudier (LinkAir) 11
- 27 Since the leading candidate received 23 out of 34 votes cast (68%), a second  
28 ballot was required.
- 29 • The Secretariat reminded the TSG of the rules of WPD Article 28 indicating  
30 that the second ballot would be determined by simple majority.
- 31 • The second ballot was then distributed to the voting members of each company  
32 present and eligible to vote. The submitted ballots were then collected and  
33 counted by the Secretariat. The results were indicated as follows:
- 34 • Jean Alphonse (Lucent) 22  
35 • Frederic Leroudier (LinkAir) 13
- 36 Based on the fact that the majority of the votes (22 of 35) were cast for Jean  
37 Alphonse (Lucent), he was confirmed as TSG-C Chair for the next term.
- 38 • The Chair then re-appointed all of the WG Chairs and the Secretary to their  
39 current positions for the next term.

1           •       The Chair noted that the only previously announced candidates for the Vice  
2           Chair positions were the current Vice Chairs:

- 3                     •       Sang-Uoon Chung (Samsung)  
4                     •       Kazuto Miyazaki (Motorola-Japan)

5           The Chair called for any additional candidates for the position of TSG-C Vice  
6           Chair and none were noted. The Chair then closed nominations for Vice Chair  
7           and reconfirmed both Vice Chairs to the current positions for the next term.

8   This session was recessed on 18 January 2001 at 7:05 PM local time.

9

10   **CLOSING PLENARY**

11   The meeting was reconvened on 19 January 2001 at 7:50 AM local time.

12   Quorum had been established at the opening Plenary and was not challenged. No additional companies  
13   were noted in attendance.

14   9.   LIAISON REPORTS (continued)

15   •       The All IP AdHoc Status Report (C00-20010115-112), including all attachments, was  
16   presented and reviewed in detail by the All IP AdHoc Liaison. As a part of this review, the  
17   following TSG-C issues were noted:

18           •       A joint meeting with TSG-C or with a representative group has been requested for the  
19           February meeting in Phoenix. The AdHoc Chair will contact the TSG-C Chair off-line  
20           to schedule.

21           •       All TSGs have been requested to consider the proposal that the AdHoc develop an All  
22           IP Network Project Release document as a high-level system specification. The  
23           contribution was remanded to WG1 to review and comment on this strategy by the  
24           requested joint meeting in Phoenix.

25   10.   OLD BUSINESS (continued): None additional.

26   11.   WORKING GROUP REPORTS (continued):

27   •       WG1 REPORT: The WG1 report (C00-20010115-101) was presented by the WG1 Chair,  
28   Phil Brown (Ericsson) as FYI.

29           •       Approved update revisions to the TSG-C Terms of References.

30           •       Deferred consideration of baseline text for C.P1001-B (Parameter Value Assignments)  
31           until the next meeting.

32           •       Approved TSG-C input to the upcoming TSG-S QoS JEM.

33           •       Approved draft framework for TSG-C work planning.

34           •       Approved updates to 3GPP2 Workplan v22.

- 1 • Approved ballot resolution text for TIA PN-4535-AD1 (Position Determination  
2 Services). That text is currently in V&V and will be submitted for approval in Phoenix.
- 3 • Determined updated projection for SMV minimum performance baseline text as August  
4 2001. The SMV algorithm description baseline text remains as March 2001.
- 5 • Continued work on the draft baseline text for the Video Streaming Specification.
- 6 • Reviewed previously remanded correspondence from TSG-S regarding alignment of  
7 character sets between SMS and IS-2000/ANSI-41. Generated correspondence to  
8 TR45.2 to determine relevant information. Plan to provide response to TSG-S next  
9 month.
- 10 • Updated TSG-C work planning process. TSG-C documents will now be classified as  
11 follows:
  - 12 • Core air interface specifications
  - 13 • Application specifications
  - 14 • Test and performance specifications

15 Proposed correspondence to TR45.2 regarding supplementary services feature codes  
16 (C00-20010115-113) was presented. This contribution was approved without objection for  
17 transmission to TR45.2 as modified by the discussion (C00-20010115113R1).

18 The proposed TSG-C input to the upcoming TSG-S QoS JEM (C00-20010115-107) was  
19 presented and summarized. This contribution was approved without objection.

20 The proposed update to the TSG-C Terms of Reference (C00-20010115-115) was presented  
21 and reviewed in detail. None of the changes related to the All IP Network development  
22 activities since WG1 determined that none were required. This contribution was approved  
23 without objection.

24 The TSG-C 2001 Workplan v0 (C00-20010115-108), complete with its new structure, was  
25 presented and reviewed in detail. This indicated that the only item from the 3GPP2 Workplan  
26 currently being worked in TSG-C is Data Field Encoding for Multi-language Support. All other  
27 3GPP2 Workplan items are either the responsibility of other TSGs or the responsibility of  
28 TSG-C and not currently being worked. One (1) planned companion document which was not  
29 included in this contribution was a listing of all 3GPP2 Workplan items for which TSG-C has or  
30 shares responsibility for. This Workplan was approved without objection and remanded to all  
31 WGs as FYI. This contribution will also be liaised to TSG-S as FYI in consideration of the  
32 framework of this process and of the workplan itself. As a part of this discussion:

- 33 • WG5 was remanded the task of projecting the publication date for any 1xEV-DV  
34 specification by the next meeting. This task will involve revisiting the WG5 technology  
35 evaluation schedule and then coordinating with WG2 and WG3 to determine their text  
36 development schedules.

- 1 • V&V was also remanded the task of determining the completion schedule for the  
2 Release B specifications by the next meeting.
- 3 The proposed changes to the 3GPP2 Workplan v22 (C00-20010115-109) were presented  
4 and reviewed. The changes were noted in purple. The contribution was approved without  
5 objection and was directed to be liaised to TSG-S.
- 6 • WG2 REPORT: The WG2 report (C00-20010115-102) was presented by the WG2 Chair,  
7 Orlett Pearson (Lucent) as FYI.
- 8 • Considering additional discrepancies in both Release 0 and Release A.
- 9 • Working on Rescue Channel issues with WG3
- 10 • Working on QPCH soft handoff issues with WG3
- 11 • Will generate a list of features and functionality which was added to TSG-C documents  
12 in 2000 for presentation next month.
- 13 • Reviewing correspondence from TR45.2 regarding the addition of a Mobile Initiated  
14 Position Determination (MO-PD) indicator in the Extended Systems Parameter  
15 Message. Plan to respond next month.
- 16 • WG3 REPORT: The WG3 report (C00-20010115-103) was presented by the WG3 Chair,  
17 Ed Tiedemann (QUALCOMM) as FYI.
- 18 • Generated response correspondences to ITU-R regarding RSPC updates.
- 19 • Additional review and Rescue Channel is still in process.
- 20 • Also reviewing provisions for soft handoff on the QPCH.
- 21 Draft Liaison Response to ITU-R Circular Letter 8/LCCE/85+Corr.1 (C00-20010115-110)  
22 was presented and reviewed. Proposed Revision Material for ITU-R Recommendation  
23 M.1457 Section 5.2 (C00-20010115-111) was also presented and reviewed. Both  
24 correspondences were approved without objection as modified by the discussion  
25 (C00-20010115-110R1 and C00-20010115-111R3) for liaison to all 3GPP2 SDOs for their  
26 consideration of submission to the 4th meeting of ITU-R WP 8F.. These contributions were  
27 also liaised directly to TR45.5.
- 28 • WG4 REPORT: The WG4 report (C00-20010115-104) was presented by John Fessler  
29 (SPCS) as FYI.
- 30 • Review of advance ballot comments on Base Station Minimum Performance  
31 Specification (C.S0010-A), Mobile Station Minimum Performance Specification  
32 (C.S0011-A), TDSO (C.S0026), MSO (C.S0025), and LSO (C.S0013-A) are in  
33 process.
- 34 • Plan to present proposed publication text C.S0010-A, C.S0026, and C.S0025 at the  
35 opening Plenary next month.



- 1 • Baseline text of the Signaling Conformance Test specification is planned for opening  
2 Plenary next month. A project number for this document has been requested and the  
3 Secretary will advise by e-mail exploder.
- 4 • Peter Gaal (QUALCOMM) was appointed as the SWG4.3 Chair and Dave Whipple  
5 (Agilent Technologies) was appointed as the Vice Chair.
- 6 Proposed correspondence to ARIB regarding clarifications on the Minimum Performance  
7 Specifications (C.S0010-A and C.S0011-A) (C00-20010115-114) was presented. This  
8 contribution was approved without objection for transmission to ARIB.
- 9 • WG5 REPORT: The WG5 report (C00-20010115-105) was presented by the WG5  
10 Co-Chair, Ed Tiedemann (QUALCOMM) as FYI.
- 11 • The Decision Criteria matrix was approved and the Decision Criteria AdHoc was  
12 disbanded. The WG3 Chair thanked Decision Criteria AdHoc Chair, Eric Jacks  
13 (LinkAir), for his efforts.
- 14 • Substantial progress was made with respect to issues from the Evaluation AdHoc but  
15 the work continues. Regular conference calls have been scheduled between now and  
16 the next meeting.
- 17 • Agreed that evaluation framework proposers need to provide the following information:
- 18 • Description of proposal
- 19 • Completed Decision Criteria template
- 20 • Completed analysis results as specified by the performance evaluation  
21 document
- 22 • Sufficient information for any other company to confirm the simulation data
- 23 • LGE has presented additional component proposals.
- 24 • Nortel Networks has updated their framework proposal.
- 25 • Although a detailed analysis has not been completed, there are some concerns regarding  
26 compliance with the previously published technology assessment schedule.
- 27 • WG6 REPORT: The V&V Report was presented verbally by the V&V Vice Chair, Geoff  
28 Cheadle (LinkAir) as FYI:
- 29 • Held initial meetings as the newly formed WG.
- 30 • Attempting to implement newly approved V&V processes.
- 31 • None of Release B was completed this week. V&V was discontinued for lack of  
32 support.

- 1           •       The plan for the February meeting in Phoenix is to begin with IS-820-1 (R-UIM) and  
 2           IS-801-1 (Position Location). These should take no more than about two hours. WG6  
 3           will then address Release B documents. They plan to complete C.P0001-B,  
 4           C.P0003-B, and C.P0005-B by the end of the meeting. It may be possible also to  
 5           address C.P0002-B in tandem with the others, but completion of that and C.P0004-B  
 6           and C.P0006-B is not planned. This planning assumes adequate support as required by  
 7           the V&V Requirements document (C00-20010115-015), which was approved at the  
 8           Opening Plenary.

9   11.   NEW BUSINESS: None additional.

10 12.   ASSIGNMENTS:

- 11           •       The Chair must decide which group within TSG-C will develop the update to C.S0008  
 12           MC-MAP.
- 13           •       The Chair must talk off-line with the TSG-S All IP AdHoc Chair to schedule a joint  
 14           meeting between the AdHoc and TSG-C or a representative group during the  
 15           February 2001 meeting in Phoenix, AZ.
- 16           •       The Secretary must assign a project number for the Signaling Conformance Test  
 17           document.
