14 **Abstract:**

15 This document is a summary of the 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings that were held during the period
16 20-24 August 2001 in Portland, OR.

1 During the period of 20-24 August 2001, meetings of 3GPP2 TSG-C were held at the Doubletree
2 Hotel Portland - Columbia River in Portland, OR. This document is intended to summarize those
3 proceedings.

5 **OPENING PLENARY**

- 6 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order at
7 10:30 AM local time on 20 August 2001 by TSG-C Chair, Jean Alphonse (Lucent).
- 8 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of companies indicated
9 that 37 companies included on the list of 42 active members were present and thus quorum was
10 established (88% participation).
- 11 3. INTRODUCTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were
12 loaded onto the 3GPP2 server and listed in the document register (C00-20010820-000).
- 13 4. AGENDA APPROVAL: The proposed agenda (C00-20010820-001) was presented and
14 approved without objection as modified by the discussion (C00-20010820-001R1).
- 15 5. ASSIGNMENTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO AGENDA ITEMS: Contributions were
16 assigned to agenda items.
- 17 6. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY: The summary for the July 2001
18 meeting in Montreal, PQ (C00-20010820-002) was presented and approved without objection
19 as submitted.

5 contributor was also directed to submit this contribution to TSG-S for consideration
6 with a request that they take action by their closing Plenary.
- 7 • Comments on the 1xEV-DV process (C00-20010820-028) were presented by
8 CWTS and LinkAir. This contribution stressed the importance of spectral efficiency
9 and of the 1xEV/DV requirements set by TSG-S. This contribution was remanded to
10 WG5 as FYI.
- 11 • The Chair indicated his intent to establish Plenary sessions every evening in September
12 in Kyoto to be used only if necessary to facilitate the framework proposal selection
13 process.

15 This session was recessed on 20 August 2001 at 12:30 PM local time.

18 The meeting was reconvened on 24 August 2001 at 9:00 AM local time.

19 Quorum had been established at the opening Plenary and was not challenged. One (1) additional
20 member company on the TSG-C active roster was noted in attendance.

24 correspondence from TSG-C but was addressed to all TSGs based on the

5 contribution had been changed to noted the purpose of the contribution was to
6 document the procedure that these operators would be using to determine their
7 preference in framework proposals if normal TSG-C WG5 procedures failed to
8 provide a single selection recommendation. As such, this contribution was noted as
9 FYI for the TSG.

- 10 • The TSG-S Liaison Report that summarized the TSG-S activities from their August
11 2001 meeting in Portland, OR (C00-20010820-118) was presented as FYI.
- 12 • Contribution C00-20010820-119 was withdrawn since it was a duplicate of
13 contribution C00-20010820-114.
- 14 • Correspondence dated 23 August 2001 from TSG-S to TSG-N regarding the TSG-S
15 response to issues related to the RC-PDSIT Stage 1 (C00-20010820-120) was
16 presented. This contribution was remanded to WG1 for review and action as
17 appropriate.
- 18 • Correspondence dated 23 August 2001 from TSG-S to all TSGs regarding review of
19 work item worksheets (C00-20010820-121) was presented. This contribution was
20 remanded to WG1 for review and action as appropriate.

 - 32 • Assigned a new service option exclusively for the use of TSG-A for purpose of
33 differentiating High Rate Packet Data traffic from other forms of traffic.
 - 34 • Agreed that the term “High Rate Packet Data” will be used in place of the 1xEV-DO
35 terminology.
 - 36 • Makoto Tsukada of KDDI and Doug McPherson of Texas Instruments were appointed
37 to fill the two vacant WG1 Vice-Chair positions.
 - 38 • Approved baseline text for the SMV minimum performance specification.
 - 39 • Nikolai Leung of QUALCOMM was appointed to be SWG 1.2 Vice-Chair.

- 1 • Completed TIA ballot resolution on the OTASP specification.
- 2 S.P9013 SMV Minimum Performance Specification (C00-20010820-127) was presented.
- 3 This contribution was approved without objection as baseline text and remanded back to WG1
- 4 for V&V. In addition, document number C.S0034 was assigned for this document.
- 5 A liaison response to CDG regarding TTY service capabilities (C00-20010820-128) was
- 6 presented. This contribution was approved without objection for transmission pending proper
- 7 correspondence formatting by the Secretary.
- 8 Liaison correspondence to EC-SCP regarding CDMA Card Application Toolkit (CCAT)
- 9 (C00-20010820-129) was presented. This contribution was approved without objection for
- 10 transmission as modified by the discussion (C00-20010820-129R1) pending the addition of the
- 11 3GPP2 Secretariat to the cc list along with its attachment (C00-20010820-129A).
- 12 • WG2 REPORT: The WG2 report (C00-20010820-102) was presented by the WG2 Chair,
- 13 Michael Wang (Nortel Networks) as FYI.
- 14 • Work on C.S000x-A signaling documents is in process.
- 15 • Motorola has submitted an 86 page proposal to address the Sync Channel problem.
- 16 Nortel Networks have stated its objections for the WG2 record but agreed to start the
- 17 evaluation of the proposed solution.
- 18 • Completed work of the signaling portion of C.S0024 v2.1
- 19 Proposed correspondence to TSG-A regarding 1xEV-DO name and AN state information
- 20 record (C00-20010820-124). This correspondence was approved without objection for
- 21 transmission as modified by the discussion (C00-20010820-124R1) in response to TSG-A
- 22 correspondence (C00-20010820-130). The TSG-A correspondence (C00-20010820-130)
- 23 was remanded to WG2 even though it had been previously received by the WG directly.
- 24 C.S0024 1xEV-DO v2.1 (C00-20010820-123) was presented. This contribution was
- 25 approved without objection as baseline text and remanded back to WG2 and WG3 for V&V.
- 26 • WG3 REPORT: The WG3 report (C00-20010820-103) was presented by WG3 Chair, Ed
- 27 Tiedemann (QUALCOMM), as FYI.
- 28 • Developed a list of deliverables and actions for the ITU-R WP 8F RSPC related
- 29 activities.
- 30 • Reviewed ARIB comments on the most recent point release of C.S0002-A. No TIA
- 31 ballot comments had been received.
- 32 • Completed work on the physical layer of C.S0024 1xEV-DO.
- 33 The summary of ITU-R issues (C00-20010820-103A) was presented as FYI. This
- 34 contribution notes that Plenaries for both TSG-C and TR45.5 will be required on 28 September
- 35 2001 to approve ITU-R inputs.
- 36 • WG4 REPORT: The WG4 report (C00-20010820-104) was presented by WG4 Vice Chair,
- 37 Dave Whipple (Agilent), as FYI.

- 1 • Completed work on the 1xEV-DO minimum performance specifications.
- 2 • TIA ballot resolution continues on C.S0031 Signaling Conformance Tests.
- 3 • Continued work on C.P9004 Minimum Performance Specification for location services.

4 The Minimum Performance Specifications for the C.S0032 Access Network (C00-
5 20010820-115) and C.S0033 Access Terminals (C00-20010820-116) respectively. These
6 contributions were approved as baseline text and remanded to WG4 for V&V.

7

- 8 • **WG5 REPORT:** The WG5 report (C00-20010820-105) was presented by the WG5
9 Co-Chair, Ed Tiedemann (QUALCOMM), as FYI.
 - 10 • Evaluation strawman was update to v6.
 - 11 • Voice simulation was completed on 30 July 2001 (target was 28 June 2001).
 - 12 • LAS-CDMA was removed from consideration as a framework proposal and will be
13 considered as a 1xEV-DV component technology.
 - 14 • Performance results were presented for 1XTREME and L3NQS but there were several
15 sections of the evaluation methodology that were interpreted differently by the two (2)
16 groups. An AdHoc was formed to investigate these issues. The results were as
17 follows:
 - 18 • Agreement has been reached on many of the discrepancies but several issues
19 remain open.
 - 20 • There is no agreement on whether any sections of the current simulation data are
21 comparable.
 - 22 • The AdHoc will continue to meet weekly by conference call to resolve open
23 issues.
 - 24 • A WG3 conference call will be held on 5 September 2001
 - 25 • Phase 2 methodology is behind schedule.

26 No actions requested from the Plenary.

27 Ericsson requested to know whether or not the 24 August 2001 milestone entitled "Phase 1
28 Forward Link Results and Decision Criteria Matrix Update Submitted" had been completed.
29 The WG5 Co-Chair indicated that the WG5 had insufficient data at this time to determine
30 whether that milestone had been completed or not. As a result of this discussion, the WG5
31 report was modified (C00-20010820-105R1) to reflect this position.

- 32 • **WG6 REPORT:** No report. Still no V&V Chair.

33 10. **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1 • Proposed correspondence over the signature of the 3GPP2 SC Chair to CDG in
2 response to their 1xEV-DV status queries (C00-20010820-126) was presented by the
3 Secretary. This correspondence was approved without objection for transmission to
4 the 3GPP2 SC Chair as modified by the discussion (C00-20010820-126R1).
- 5 • The Chair noted that the 3GPP/3GPP2 harmonization meeting will be scheduled for the
6 week of 12 November 2001 in the New York area. A detailed meeting schedule and
7 agenda will be distributed.

8 11. ASSIGNMENTS: None specifically identified during the meeting.

- 9 • The Chair will arrange for the 28 September 2001 interim Plenary conference call to
10 approve ITU-R inputs.
- 11 • The Secretary will be responsible for meeting notices for the 6-8 November 2001
12 meetings of WG2 and WG2. A WG5 meeting notice will also be issued if necessary.
13 Obviously, the WG Chairs must be responsible for the meeting agenda.
