1 During the period of 10-14 June 2002, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Crowne Plaza
2 Shenzhen Hotel in Shenzhen, China. This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

4 OPENING PLENARY

5 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order at
6 8:40 AM local time on 10 June 2002 by TSG-C Chair, Jean Alphonse (Lucent).

7 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of companies indicated
8 that 18 companies included on the list of 39 active members were present(46% participation).
9 By this count, quorum was not achieved.

10 3. INTRODUCTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were
11 loaded onto the 3GPP2 network server and listed in the document register (C0020020610--
12 000).

13 4. AGENDA APPROVAL: The proposed agenda (C00-20020610-001) was presented. There

15 quorum. However, the meeting proceeded based on this agenda without formal agenda
16 approval.
