1 During the period of 9-13 September 2002, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Cheju Shilla
2 Hotel in Cheju, Korea. This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

4 OPENING PLENARY

5 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order at
6 10:30 AM local time on 9 September 2002 by TSG-C Chair, Jean Alphonse (Lucent).

7 The Chair welcomed everyone to Cheju and thanked TTA for hosting this meeting.

8 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of companies indicated
9 that 20 companies included on the list of 37 active members were present (54% participation).

10 The Secretary noted the receipt of one (1) proxy letter for this meeting. Alltel has granted their
11 proxy to Sprint PCS for this meeting.

12 3. INTRODUCTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were
13 loaded onto the 3GPP2 network server and listed in the document register (C00-20020909-
14 000R1).

15 4. AGENDA APPROVAL: The proposed agenda (C00-20020909-001R2) was presented.
16 **DECISION: The agenda (C00-20020909-001R2) was approved without objection as**
17 **submitted.**

18 5. ASSIGNMENTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO AGENDA ITEMS: Contributions were
19 assigned to agenda items as noted on the agenda.

20 6. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY: The meeting summary of the
21 August 2002 meeting in Portland, OR (C00-20020909-002) was presented. Since the
22 summary was not available, discussion on the meeting summary was deferred until the closing
23 Plenary.

24 7. CORRESPONDENCE:

25 • A request for addendum to cdma2000 Release C (C00-20020909-003) was
26 presented by LGE. This contribution presented a list of bugs and clarification for
27 cdma2000 Release C to be used as the basis of discussion for the next point release of
28 this specification. **ACTION: This contribution (C00-20020909-003) was**
29 **remanded to WG2 and WG3 to be used as a basis for collecting future**
30 **contributions for Release C bug fixes for action sometime in the future.**

31 • Request for Work Item for C.P0017-0-3 (C00-20020909-004) was presented by the
32 SWG1.3 Chair, Bob Marks (Samsung). The SWG has determined that this point
33 release is required to fix bugs related to ambiguities in parsing of the QoS BLOB
34 contained in C.S0017-0-2 (TIA/EIA/IS-707-A-2). **DECISION: The Plenary**
35 **authorized without objection the development of the next point release to**
36 **C.P0017-0 by SWG1.3 per this request (C00-20020909-004).**

- 1 • A contribution on Lucent comments on "Candidate TSG-C Work Items for 2002/2003
2 work planning timeframe" (C00-20020909-005) was presented by Lucent. This
3 contribution provided comments regarding the work items to be included in the TSG-C
4 workplan for the next 6-18 months. **ACTION: This contribution (C00-20020909-
5 005) was remanded to WG1 for review and action as appropriate.**
- 6 • A contribution on 2003 work item priorities (C00-20020909-006) was presented from
7 Airvana. This contribution proposes Airvana's input to priority for a set of candidate
8 work items that has been developed during last meeting. **ACTION: This
9 contribution (C00-20020909-006) was remanded to WG1 for review and action
10 as appropriate.**
- 11 • A contribution on High Priority for Broadcast/Multicast Services in TSG-C (C00-
12 20020909-007) was presented by QUALCOMM on behalf of four (4) additional
13 co-contributors. This contribution requests that the broadcast multicast services be
14 included as high priority items in the TSG-C work. **ACTION: This contribution
15 (C00-20020909-007) was remanded to WG1 for review and action as
16 appropriate.**
- 17 • A contribution on a Work Item for Developing a Packet Data Performance
18 Specification (C00-20020909-008) was presented by QUALCOMM. This
19 contribution includes a detailed proposal for TSG-C development of a packet data
20 performance specification for the air interface for cdma2000 Release D. During the
21 ensuing discussion, the following comments were made:
- 22 • This capability is intended to be an end-to-end feature.
23 • This capability is not intended to really be a performance specification but rather a
24 set of standard measurement/testing practices.
25 • This capability is intended to be air interface agnostic to the greatest degree
26 possible.
- 27 QUALCOMM noted that they did intend to request a work item in TSG-S for an
28 end-to-end feature. This contribution was left open at the Plenary level for future
29 discussion.
- 30 • A contribution on Electro-acoustic Requirements Work in TSG-C (C00-20020909-
31 009) was presented by QUALCOMM on behalf of co-contributor Kyocera. This
32 contribution proposes creation of a new AdHoc under WG1 to address the
33 Electro-acoustic requirements of CDMA mobile stations for Speech Service Options.
34 **ACTION: This contribution (C00-20020909-009) was remanded to WG1 and
35 WG4 for review and action as appropriate.**
- 36 • E-mail correspondence regarding review and approval of C.S0042-0 Circuit-Switched
37 Video Conferencing Services (C00-20020909-023) was presented from the 3GPP2
38 Secretariat. This contribution was noted as FYI for the TSG.

- 1 • Information related to ITU-R RSPC Part 5-2 Rev. 1 v2 (C00-20020909-024) was
2 presented from the Chair. This contribution had been previously liaised from TR45.5 to
3 WG3 so no further action was taken by TSG-C.
- 4 • A contribution on Prioritization of TSG-C Work Items (C00-20020909-025) was
5 presented by QUALCOMM. This contribution recommended recommends that the
6 work item on HRPD performance enhancements be treated with the highest priority
7 (priority 1 - essential) among candidate work items for 2002/2003. This work item is to
8 continue improving the performance of systems based on C.S0024 (IS-856) to meet
9 the requirements set in S.R0023 (High-Speed Data Enhancements for cdma2000 1x -
10 Data Only, Stage 1 Requirements). The outcome of this work item will lead to a
11 revision of C.S0024 with a target completion date of July 2003. **ACTION: This**
12 **contribution (C00-20020909-025) was remanded to WG1 for review and action**
13 **as appropriate.**
- 14 • A contribution on a Proposed Draft Stage 2 for Broadcast-Multicast Service (v0.0.5)
15 (C00-20020909-035) was presented by Lucent. There was substantial discussion on
16 which TSG should coordinate the development of this end-to-end feature that may
17 require support from most of the 3GPP2 TSGs. However, the point was made that
18 there was substantial air interface signaling support required. **ACTION: This**
19 **contribution (C00-20020909-035) was remanded to WG1 and WG2 for review**
20 **and action as appropriate.**
- 21 • A contribution on Modification of BCCH discrepancy in cdma2000 Rel-A, B, and C
22 (C00-20020909-036) was presented by KDDI. This contribution recommended that
23 a BCCH discrepancy remedy, identified in C00-20011105-005), be included in point
24 releases of cdma2000 Release A, Release B, and Release C. There was substantial
25 discussion on whether or not this was related to the Sync Channel and a strong
26 resistance was expressed by Lucent and Samsung to address this contribution if it was
27 indeed related to the Sync Channel. This contribution was held open at the Plenary
28 level. The contributor was requested to submit a technically substantive contribution to
29 convince WG2 that this problem is indeed a technical bug that affects mobiles other than
30 those that are Sync Channel non-compliant.
- 31 • E-mail correspondence dated 6 September 2002 requesting TSG input on the 3GPP2
32 budget for year 2003 (C00-20020909-037) was presented from the 3GPP2
33 Secretariat. This contribution was held open at the Plenary level pending review at the
34 Chair's meeting.

12 approved by the SC. **ACTION: This contribution (C00-20020909-030)
13 was remanded to all WGs as FYI.**
- 14 • The Recommendation on Roles and Responsibilities for Project Management in
15 3GPP2 (C00-20020909-031) was presented from Motorola as presented to
16 the SC. There was some question about whether or not this contribution had
17 been remanded to all TSGs so the document was held open at the Plenary level
18 pending confirmation with the 3GPP2 Secretariat.
- 19 • Correspondence dated 27 August 2002 regarding a Sync Channel workaround
20 (C00-20020909-032) was presented from CDG as FYI. Based on the SC
21 decision to "take no further action at this time regarding the Sync Channel
22 issue":
- 23 • **DECISION: The Chair officially canceled the cdma2000
24 Release A point release that included the Sync Channel fix.**
- 25 • **DECISION: The Chair officially closed the cdma2000 Release
26 A documents with the Sync Channel fix that had been held open

38 the October 2002 meeting.**

4 their proposal recommended two (2) “additional” TSGs. They indicate that
5 they actually proposed two (2) new TSGs but the total number of TSGs would
6 be maintained at five (5).
