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**APPROVED SUMMARY OF 3GPP2 TSG-C MEETINGS**  
for 14-18 April 2003 in Coeur d'Alene, ID, USA

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**Abstract:**

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This document is a summary of the 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings that were held during the period of 14-18 April 2003 in Coeur d'Alene, ID, USA.

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1 During the period of 14-18 April 2003, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Coeur d'Alene  
2 Resort in Coeur d'Alene, ID, USA. This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

#### 4 OPENING PLENARY

5 • CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order at  
6 8:25 AM local time on 14 April 2003 by TSG-C Chair, BK Yi (LGE). The Chair  
7 welcomed everyone to Coeur d'Alene, ID.

8 • ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of companies  
9 indicated that 22 companies included on the list of 32 quorum members were present  
10 (69% participation).

11 The Secretary noted that no proxy statements had been received.

12 • INTRODUCTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were  
13 loaded onto the 3GPP2 network server and listed in the document register (C00-  
14 20030414-000).

15 • AGENDA APPROVAL: The proposed agenda (C00-20030414-001) was presented.  
16 **DECISION: The agenda (C00-20030414-001) was approved without objection as**  
17 **submitted.**

18 • ASSIGNMENTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO AGENDA ITEMS: Contributions were  
19 assigned to agenda items as noted on the agenda.

20 • APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY: The summary of the abbreviated  
21 March 2003 meeting in Vancouver, BC, Canada (C00-20030414-002) was presented.  
22 **DECISION: The March 2003 meeting summary (C00-20030414-002) was approved**  
23 **without objection as submitted.**

24 • REVIEW OF OUTSTANDING ACTIONS FROM PREVIOUS MEETING: The action  
25 items from the previous meeting were noted as follows:

26 • *The TSG-S Liaison was requested to verify the status of the Enhanced Call*  
27 *Recovery Stage 1.* The TSG-S Liaison noted that the ECR feature had been  
28 inadvertently omitted on the previously distributed TSG-S Stage 1 Document  
29 Status Table. This omission will be corrected on the next release of the Stage 1  
30 Document Status Table.

31 • *WG1, WG2, and WG3 to review the requests for action on HRPD*  
32 *Enhancements with respect to their current workload and development*  
33 *schedule and to make recommendations on how to incorporate HRPD*  
34 *Enhancements into their workplan. These recommendations will be initially*  
35 *discussed at the TSG-C Chair's meeting and then reviewed, with potential*  
36 *recommendations from the TSG-C Chair's team, by the TSG-C membership.*  
37 This action was noted as still open and work on this item will be progressed this  
38 week.

- 1       •     *All WGs were directed to consider whether a meeting in the June 2003*  
2       *timeframe will be required. The schedule of 16-20 June was proposed by*  
3       *QUALCOMM for consideration if the meeting is deemed to be necessary.* This  
4       action was noted as still open and work on this item will be progressed this week.
- 5       •     CORRESPONDENCE: None.
- 6       •     LIAISON REPORTS:
- 7       •     OP MEETING: No contributions.
- 8       •     SC: No contributions.
- 9       •     3GPP2 SECRETARIAT: The following contributions were discussed:
- 10      •     A contribution on a Request for Input - 3GPP2 Contribution Numbering  
11      (C00-20030414-004) was presented from the 3GPP2 Secretariat. This  
12      contribution was noted as FYI for the TSG.
- 13      •     Correspondence dated 27 March 2003 to TR45, TR45.5, and the 3GPP2  
14      Secretariat regarding cdma2000<sup>®</sup> trademark usage (C00-20030414-005)  
15      plus associated clarification e-mails were presented from the TIA Legal  
16      Counsel. This contribution noted that “cdma2000” is now a trademark  
17      and certification mark owned by TIA. As such, usage in 3rd party  
18      documents (including 3GPP2 specifications and reports) must use  
19      cdma2000 with the registered mark (i.e., cdma2000<sup>®</sup>). Editors must be  
20      directed to update all 3GPP2 documents to reflect this direction when they  
21      are next released. **ACTION: This contribution (C00-20030414-005)**  
22      **was remanded to all WGs for review and action as appropriate.**
- 23      •     TSG-A: No contributions.
- 24      •     TSG-S: The following contributions were discussed:
- 25      •     Correspondence dated 4 April 2003 regarding rescheduling of the Joint  
26      Meeting for the Resolution of TSG Review comments on the Evolution  
27      Document (S.P0038), Version 1.1.1 (C00-20030414-008) was presented  
28      from TSG-S. This correspondence noted that the referenced joint meeting  
29      has been rescheduled to 13 May 2003. **ACTION: This contribution**  
30      **(C00-20030414-008) was remanded to all WGs as FYI.**
- 31      •     TSG-X: The following contributions were discussed:
- 32      •     Correspondence dated 4 April 2003 regarding TSG-X Secretary (C00-  
33      20030414-006) was presented from TSG-X. This correspondence noted  
34      that Cathy Fitzpatrick (Lucent) has agreed to serve as the new TSG-X  
35      Secretary. Her contact information was included in the correspondence.  
36      This contribution was noted as FYI for the TSG.
- 37      •     Correspondence dated 4 April 2003 regarding follow-up on Joint TSG-X  
38      (CSN WG) Meeting with TSG-C (re: C.S0022) (C00-20030414-007) was  
39      presented from TSG-X. **ACTION: This correspondence was**  
40      **remanded to WG1 for review and action as appropriate and to WG2**  
41      **as FYI.**

- 1           •       TR45: No contributions.
- 2   9.    WORKING GROUP REPORTS:
- 3           •       WG1 Chair, Phil Brown (Ericsson), noted the following plan of activities for  
4           continuation of work for this week:
- 5               •       Held two (2) conference calls during the interim since the last meeting,  
6               one (1) of which was devoted to MMS.
- 7               •       A special session of WG1, again devoted to MMS, will be held on
- 8               •       SWG1.1 will begin to review candidates for the wideband codec this  
9               week.
- 10            •       SWG1.3 completed ballot resolution activities associated with  
11            LLA\_RHOC and is expected to bring in ballot resolution text this week.  
12            This group is also targeting completion of the next revision of the Data  
13            Services specification in May 2003.
- 14            •       SWG1.4 progress the work on their documents.
- 15            •       SWG1.6 continues the work on the Location Services specification.
- 16            •       Eight (8) hours of Requirements AdHoc meeting are scheduled for this  
17            week.
- 18            •       WG1 has not discussed the potential of a June 2003 face-to-face meeting  
19            but the WG1 Chair does not see the need. However, the WG1 Chair will  
20            report a summary of the WG discussions on this issue at the closing  
21            Plenary.
- 22            •       The WG1 Chair had also updated the TSG-C workplan  
23            (C00-20030414-013) for discussion at the joint WG meeting immediately  
24            following the TSG-C and TR45.5 opening Plenaries. The contributions  
25            for that joint meeting will be numbered as opening Plenary documents.
- 26            •       WG2 Chair, Orlett Pearson (Lucent), noted the WG2 meeting summary from the  
27            last meeting (C00-20030414-010) and the interim conference calls (C00-  
28            20030414-011):
- 29               •       Formed an AdHoc to review the TSG-C workplan. WG2 intends to  
30               forward their comments to WG1 this week.
- 31               •       Progressed work on shared FCH/DCCH and upper layer design for the  
32               RL.
- 33               •       WG2 will discuss the need for face-to-face meetings in June 2003 this  
34               week.
- 35               •       SWG2.3 held three (3) interim conference calls to progress the work on  
36               F-PDCH & F-SCH support, Open Loop Estimation for CAM in Page, and  
37               the PLCM bug fix.
- 38            •       WG3 Chair, Ed Tiedemann (QUALCOMM), noted the following plan of  
39            activities for continuation of work for this week:
- 40               •       Held five (5) conference calls during the interim since the last meeting and  
41               received almost 100 contributions.

- 1                   •       Most of the work has been focused on the calibration activities.
- 2                   •       This week, the group will plan their process to review the RL proposals on
- 3                   the table.
- 4                   •       WG3 does plan to hold face-to-face meetings in June 2003.
- 5                   •       Dave Whipple (Agilent), noted the following plan of activities for continuation of
- 6                   WG4 work for this week:
- 7                   •       Plans to bring the point release for the AT/AN MPS documents to closing
- 8                   Plenary this week.
- 9                   •       WG4 has no plans for face-to-face meetings in June 2003.
- 10   10.    OLD BUSINESS: No contributions.
- 11   11.    ITU PROCESS/APPROVAL:
- 12                   •       E-mail correspondence dated 21 March 2003 from the ITU Program Manager
- 13                   (C00-20030414-013) regarding the update of recommendation ITU-R M.1457 to
- 14                   revision 3. **ACTION: This contribution was remanded to WG3 for review**
- 15                   **and action as appropriate by the ITU AdHoc.**
- 16                   •       The TR45.5 Chair, Jean Alphonse (Lucent), noted that work on M.1457 was
- 17                   progressed at the most recent ITU WP 8F meeting in Brazil. The documentation
- 18                   required for submission from all 3GPP2 SDOs was received in a timely manner.
- 19                   He made the contributions from that meeting available on the server.
- 20   12.    NEW BUSINESS:
- 21                   •       A contribution regarding HRPD Rev A standardization guidelines (C00-20030414-009)
- 22                   was presented from ALLTEL and QUALCOMM. This contribution presents the
- 23                   contributors' view on an approach to evaluate proposed HRPD enhancements and
- 24                   develop C.S0024-A High Rate Packet Data (HRPD) Revision A. This contribution
- 25                   recommended the following guidelines:
- 26                   •       The approved TSG-C work plan for 2003 should be adhered to.
- 27                   •       Adopt an evaluation approach similar to 1xEV-DV to develop Revision A
- 28                   enhancements to HRPD by using as much of the existing 1xEV-DV evaluation
- 29                   methodology as applicable to HRPD to leverage previous efforts and minimize
- 30                   resolution of a modified process for HRPD.
- 31                   •       HRPD Revision A activities should start in the April 2003 meeting, with ongoing
- 32                   meeting time allocated from April 2003 on, as appropriate, based upon TSG-C
- 33                   workload requirements.
- 34                   The following process is recommended:
- 35                   •       Scope Definition: Identification of HRPD Revision A content (i.e.,
- 36                   enhancements)
- 37                   •       Evaluation Methodology: Adaptation of the 1xEV-DV Evaluation Methodology
- 38                   for HRPD Rev. A and establish an associated HRPD baseline.
- 39                   •       Proposal Submission: Submission and discussions of proposals.

- 1 • Evaluation and Design: Evaluation of proposals, formation of the final design,  
2 and text development.
- 3 • Completion: Release for SDO review.

4 The following additional recommendations were also proposed:

- 5 • Begin Scope Definition and Evaluation Methodology in a WG3 AdHoc. Scope  
6 definition will remain open through May 2003. The AdHoc will initially meet  
7 serially with WG3 to allow maximum participation. However, this work must be  
8 structured to minimize the impact to cdma2000 Rev. D.
- 9 • Proposal Submission as well as Evaluation and Design should be accommodated  
10 in WG2 and WG3 with AdHoc support as necessary.

11 **ACTION: An HRPD AdHoc was formed to resolve concerns related to the wording**  
12 **of this proposal. Dennis Gentzler (ALLTEL) and Tao Chen (QUALCOMM) were**  
13 **named as the AdHoc Chairs.**

14 **ACTION: An interim Plenary was scheduled for Wednesday at 5:00 PM to receive**  
15 **the report of this AdHoc and to determine action accordingly.**

- 16 • A suggestion was made by Lucent to start the May meeting at 1:00 PM in light of the fact  
17 that Sunday is Mother's Day. There was no consensus on this suggestion. Lucent then  
18 requested that the 3GPP2 Meeting Planner be notified that this week should not be used  
19 for meetings in the future due to its impact on Easter celebrations.
- 20 • Plenary contribution numbers assigned for the joint WG meeting included the following:

29 three (3) additional 3GPP2 member companies noted in attendance.

3                   **was remanded to WG2 for review and action as appropriate.**

5                   Packet Data Service Instances (C00-20030414-051) was presented from TSG-A.  
6                   **ACTION: This contribution was remanded to WG1 and WG2 for review**  
7                   **and action as appropriate.**
- 8           •       The summary of joint meeting between TSG-A, TSG-C, and TSG-X regarding  
9                   multiple service instances (C00-20030414-052) was presented from TSG-A.  
10                  **ACTION: This contribution was remanded to WG1 and WG2 as FYI.**
- 11          •       Proposed correspondence to TSG-X regarding BCMCS Framework status  
12                   (C00-20030414-053) was presented from WG2. **DECISION: This contribution**  
13                   **was approved without objection for transmission as modified by the**  
14                   **discussion (C00-20030414-053R1).**

15 This session was recessed on 16 April 2003 at 6:10 PM local time.

28                   only a contribution numbering issue when, in fact, the referenced correspondence  
29                   from TSG-N had proposed two (2) changes to the WPD and only one (1) of them  
30                   was related to contribution number. In response to that correspondence, the  
31                   Secretary proposed correspondence to the 3GPP2 Secretariat regarding TSG-N  
32                   proposed changes to the WPD (C00-20030414-109). **DECISION: This**  
33                   **contribution was approved without objection for transmission as modified by**  
34                   **the discussion (C00-20030414-109R1).**

- 3 Chair, Phil Brown (Ericsson), as FYI.
- 4 • Continued to progress the work on C.P0045-0 MMS Media Formats and Codecs.
- 5 A provisional agreement was reached with respect to content and placement of
- 6 text associated with SMIL. Productive discussion was held with respect to a
- 7 default mandatory video codec (i.e., H.263 Baseline or MPEG-4). CDG input on
- 8 the speech codec was not received but is expected shortly. A teleconference has
- 9 been scheduled for Wednesday, May 7 from 5-7 PM CDT to review the CDG
- 10 input.
- 11 • Approved publication text for C.P1001-D (Parameter Value Assignments).
- 12 • Approved publication text for C.P9021 (LLA\_ROHC, to be published as
- 13 C.S0047-0 v1.0).
- 14 • The resignations of DS Park (Samsung) and John Villasenor (UCLA) as SWG1.2
- 15 Co-Chairs were confirmed. Announced the appointment of Keith Miller (Nokia),
- 16 current Co-Vice-Chair and Acting Chair since January, as the new Chair of
- 17 SWG1.2.
- 18 • The WBC Selection test data analyses were presented to the SWG by the
- 19 Listening Lab, and discussed in detail by the SWG. Subsequent to SWG approval
- 20 of the listening-lab report, concluding that WBC1 was selected as winner of the
- 21 Selection process, it was revealed that the selected codec was that provided by
- 22 Nokia.**DECISION: Proposed baseline text for C.P0049-0 R-UIM**
- 23 **Conformance Testing Specification (C00-20030414-107) was approved**
- 24 **without objection. ACTION: This contribution was remanded to WG1 for**
- 25 **V&V.**
- 26 **DECISION: Proposed baseline text for C.P0040-0 IOTA-HCM Specification**
- 27 **(C00-20030414-110) was approved without objection. ACTION: This contribution**
- 28 **was remanded to WG1 for V&V.**
- 29 **DECISION: Proposed publication text for C.P9021 -0 v0.99 Link-Layer Assisted**
- 30 **Service Options for Voice-over-IP: Header Removal (SO 60) and Robust Header**
- 31 **Compression (SO 61) (formerly LLA\_RHOC) (C00-20030414-111) was approved**
- 32 **without objection for publication as C.S0047-0 v1.0. ACTION: The TIA versions of**
- 33 **this contribution were liaised to TR45.5.**
- 34 **DECISION: The TSG-C Workplan v3 (C00-20030414-112) was adopted without**
- 35 **objection.**
- 36 The updated TSG-C Document Catalogue/Project List (C00-20030414-113) was noted as
- 37 FYI.
- 38 **DECISION: Proposed publication text for C.P1001-D v0.99 Parameter Value**
- 39 **Assignments (C00-20030414-114) was approved without objection for publication as**
- 40 **C.R1001-D v1.0.**



1 **DECISION: Proposed correspondence to ITU-T regarding EV and MSC-VBR**  
2 **speech codecs (C00-20030414-115R2) was approved without objection for**  
3 **transmission.**

4 **DECISION: Proposed correspondence to TSG-S regarding Stage 1 reviews for**  
5 **April 2003 (C00-20030414-116R1) was approved without objection for transmission.**

6 **DECISION: Proposed correspondence to TSG-S regarding work item review**  
7 **(C00-20030414-117) was approved without objection for transmission.**

- 8 • WG2 REPORT: The WG2 report (C00-20030414-102) was presented by the WG2  
9 Chair, Orlett Pearson (Lucent), as FYI.
- 10 • WG2 has confirmed that they will meet face-to-face, in conjunction with WG3  
11 meetings, during the week of 16 June 2003 and requests that the network server  
12 support must be available for those meetings. Tuesday through Thursday of that  
13 meeting will be devoted to cdma2000 Rev. D.
  - 14 • Based on discussions at the opening Plenary, a WG2 AdHoc was formed to  
15 generate status query correspondence to TSG-X regarding the activities of the  
16 BCMCS Framework AdHoc. That correspondence was approved and transmitted  
17 from the interim Plenary. An additional correspondence was also generated  
18 regarding BCMCS for HRPD.
  - 19 • Generated a response to TSG-A concerns regarding ESN/MEID.
  - 20 • Completed review of the TSG-C workplan and forwarded comments to WG1.
  - 21 • Began preliminary discussions on HRPD.

22 The TSG-C Chair requested WG2 consideration of a joint meeting with WG3 on HRPD  
23 on Friday at the June meeting. The discussions indicated that Monday afternoon of that  
24 week might be better for scheduling the HRPD meeting. **ACTION: The WG2 Chair**  
25 **will solicit direction from the WG and work directly with the WG3 Chair in an**  
26 **attempt to respond to the TSG Chair's request.**

27 **DECISION: Proposed correspondence to TSG-A regarding ESN/MEID (C00-**  
28 **20030414-119) was approved without objection for transmission with its**  
29 **attachments pending the addition of TSG-X on the cc list.**

30 **DECISION: Proposed correspondence to TSG-X regarding HRPD BCMCS (C00-**  
31 **20030414-120) was approved without objection for transmission.**

- 32 • WG3 REPORT: The WG3 report (C00-20030414-103) was presented by the WG3  
33 Chair, Ed Tiedemann (QUALCOMM) , as FYI.
- 34 • WG3 received 121 contributions between last meeting and this meeting and  
35 another 118 at this meeting so the WG has been very busy.
  - 36 • The WG reviewed correspondence from the ITU. It was determined that the ITU  
37 AdHoc should meet in July to begin preparations for the next WP 8F meeting.

- 1 • Continued work on calibrating reverse link system simulations. At least four (4)  
2 companies have results that are quite close. It is expected that the remaining  
3 companies involved in the simulations will be able to get their results to match  
4 after they find remaining issues.
- 5 • Approved an updated version of the strawman (C30-20030414-046R1) but noted  
6 that the wording of the link level methodology still needs some additional  
7 refinement.
- 8 • Developed a plan to move forward on proposed RL enhancements as follows:
- 9 • Go through list of study topics and find new topics that need to be studied.
- 10 • Develop a schedule when these topics will be addressed in terms of  
11 meetings/conference calls. Verify that at least one company will address  
12 the topic but all companies are invited to bring in contributions.
- 13 • WG3 to make temporary suggestions on these assigned topics (conditional  
14 decision, etc.). These can be modified later; however, the goals are to  
15 consolidate views and to make it easier to do analysis.
- 16 • Once all topics are well understood, take them all together and make soft  
17 decisions about all topics and design a concept framework.
- 18 • Allow companies to challenge the concept framework and make further  
19 improvement.
- 20 • In addition, companies should continue to perform analyses on their own  
21 proposals, providing data as it becomes available. A decision to select a  
22 complete proposal from a company as a baseline will only be used as a  
23 backup measure.
- 24 • Make final decisions and start standard text.
- 25 • All companies are encouraged to bring in any kind of results ASAP.
- 26 • All companies are encouraged to further develop new component  
27 technologies, and technologies based on the current available proposals.
- 28 • The following assignments have been made relative to control algorithms:
- 29 • All companies are to provide descriptions of their control algorithms by  
30 the May meeting.
- 31 • Companies are to provide analysis of the control overhead for the various  
32 schemes.
- 33 • Companies are to provide analysis of the delay of the various schemes.
- 34 • A new WG3 HRPD AdHoc has been formed with Jun Li (Nortel Networks) as  
35 AdHoc Chair with responsibility to develop the following:
- 36 • Scope of work including a preliminary feature list (some of which may be  
37 WG2 only items)
- 38 • Evaluation methodology
- 39 • Baseline description of HRPD Rev. 0

40 No actions required from Plenary.

- 1 • WG4 REPORT: The WG4 report (C00-20030414-104) was presented by WG4 Vice  
2 Chair, Dave Whipple (Agilent Technologies), as FYI.
- 3 • Proposed AN-MPS and AT-MPS addenda (C.P0032-0 v1.9 and C.P0033-0 v1.9)  
4 were approved for recommendation for SDO review and comment.
- 5 • Continued to progress the work on C.P0043-0 Protocol Conformance Testing and  
6 C.P0044-0 Interoperability Testing with the goal being to baseline the documents  
7 in the May meeting.
- 8 • The status of WG4 documents in development is included in this report.

9 **DECISION: C.P0032-0 v1.9 AN-MPS (C00-20030414-105) and C.P0033-0 v1.9**  
10 **AT-MPS (C00-20030414-106) were both approved without objection for release for**  
11 **SDO review and comment. ACTION: The TIA versions of this contribution were**  
12 **liaised to TR45.5.**

13 **ACTION: The WG4 report was remanded to WG1 for review and action as**  
14 **appropriate with respect to the document status information contained in the**  
15 **report.**

18 **(C00-20030414-009), the following open contributions were closed without**
