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**APPROVED SUMMARY OF 3GPP2 TSG-C MEETINGS**  
for 18-22 August 2003 in Seoul, Korea

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**Abstract:**

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This document is a summary of the 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings that were held during the period of 18-22 August 2003 in Seoul, Korea.

**Recommendation:**

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1 During the period of 18-22 August 2003, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Sheraton  
2 Walker Hill in Seoul, Korea. This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

#### 4 OPENING PLENARY

5 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order at  
6 8:45 AM local time on 18 August 2003 by TSG-C Chair, BK Yi (LGE). The Chair  
7 welcomed everyone to Seoul and expressed the gratitude of the group to TTA for their  
8 hosting of this meeting.

9 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of companies  
10 indicated that 26 companies included on the list of 34 quorum members were present  
11 (76% participation).

12 The Secretary noted that no proxy statements had been received.

13 3. INTRODUCTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were  
14 loaded onto the 3GPP2 network server and listed in the document register (C00-  
15 20030818-000R1).

16 4. AGENDA APPROVAL: The proposed agenda (C00-20030818-001R2) was presented.  
17 **DECISION: The agenda (C00-20030818-001R2) was approved without objection as**  
18 **submitted.**

19 5. ASSIGNMENTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO AGENDA ITEMS: Contributions were  
20 assigned to agenda items as noted on the agenda.

21 6. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY: The summary of the May 2003  
22 meeting in San Diego, CA, USA (C00-20030818-002) was presented. The WG2 Chair  
23 objected based on the classification of the HRPD Rev. A schedule from WG2  
24 (C00-20030714-122) as "accepted". Lucent also objected based on the classification of  
25 both the HRPD Rev. A schedule (C00-20030714-122) and the cdma2000 Rev. D  
26 schedule (C00-20030714-123), indicating that they would not have accepted the  
27 classification of "accepted" if that had been the ruling. Several other companies  
28 indicated that the meeting report was accurate as written.. **DECISION: The July 2003**  
29 **meeting summary was approved as modified by the discussion (C00-20030818-**  
30 **002R1) over the objections of the WG2 Chair and Lucent.**

31 7. REVIEW OF OUTSTANDING ACTIONS FROM PREVIOUS MEETING: The action  
32 items from the previous meeting were noted as follows:

33 • TSG-C member companies are requested to review the Industry Notice on  
34 addressing backward compatibility (C00-20030714-119) and to provide  
35 comments by 18 August 2003. **DECISION: This action item was closed**  
36 **without objection.**

37 • The following contributions were left OPEN at the Plenary level:

38 • Undated Liaison Statement regarding DRM Content Format Statement  
39 (C00-20030714-015) from OMA MAG. This contribution remains open  
40 pending further direction from the SC.

- 1           •       WI priorities (C00-20030714-020) from ALLTEL. This contribution was  
2           left open until closing Plenary.
- 3           •       Management of the TSG-C workplan (C00-20030714-124) from KDDI,  
4           KTF, and SKT. This contribution was presented. The contributors agreed  
5           to delete the final sentence in the final paragraph before the  
6           Recommendations that states “We also note that continued attempts to  
7           delay HRPD Rev. A will be challenged and we will all lose valuable time  
8           on both projects.” This contribution remains open as modified by the  
9           discussion (C00-20030714-124R1) open until closing Plenary.
- 10          •       The Secretary was directed to stress the concerns of the TSG to the 3GPP2  
11          Secretariat regarding the impact of LAN Server problems to the TSG  
12          productivity. **DECISION: This action was closed with the presentation of**  
13          **correspondences regarding TSG-C concerns related to wireless LAN**  
14          **performance issues in SFO (C00-20030818-005) which was noted as FYI.**
- 15          •       The Secretary was directed to advise the PMT that the standing meeting times  
16          noted in C00-20030714-113 were problematic based on the heavy workload of  
17          the TSG and that lunch and evening meetings should be considered.  
18          Correspondences related to this action (C00-20030813-010) were noted as FYI.  
19          This action was held open pending discussion of other related contributions later  
20          in the agenda.
- 21          •       WG1, WG2, and WG3 to review the requests for action on HRPD Enhancements  
22          with respect to their current workload and development schedule and to make  
23          recommendations on how to incorporate HRPD Enhancements into their  
24          workplan. (WG2 schedules were accepted, WG3 final schedule still outstanding,  
25          open since March 2003). This action was noted as still open.
- 26    8.       CORRESPONDENCE: None.
- 27    9.       LIAISON REPORTS:
- 28          •       OP MEETING: Correspondence dated 31 July 2003 from the OPs to the SC  
29          Chair, the TSG-S Chair, and the PMT Chair (C00-20030818-011) was presented.  
30          This correspondence noted that OPs are supporting a new type of V&V process  
31          that may include SDO review but that is not an official 3GPP2 release for SDO  
32          review and comment. The discussion noted that this new process, once finally  
33          approved, must be incorporated into our existing/to be modified processes. This  
34          correspondence will be discussed in the PMT on Tuesday 19 August 2003 during  
35          the 8:00-10:00 AM time frame. The PMT is also considering a joint TSG  
36          meeting on this topic in Calgary during the September 2003 meeting.
- 37          Compliance with these recommendations will be required once the PMT  
38          incorporates this into the 3GPP2 Publication Process document and that document  
39          is approved by the SC. The discussion noted that additional work may also be  
40          required to the 3GPP2 WPD and the PPA. **ACTION: This document was**  
41          **remanded to all WGs for review and comment with comments, if any, to be**  
42          **coordinated by WG1.**

- 1           •       Many WG1 documents in development are still out for SDO review and  
2           comment
- 3           •       WG2 Chair, Orlett Pearson (Lucent), the following status of their activities:
- 4           •       WG2 did not meet in the interim but the WG2 SWGs did meet.
- 5           •       Continued work of cdma2000 Rev. D items
- 6           •       SWG2.5 continued V&V on HRPD BCMCS.
- 7           •       Looking to complete other features of cdma2000 Rev. D this week.
- 8           •       Anthony Soong (Ericsson) noted the following status of the WG3 activities:
- 9           •       WG3 and its AdHoc held 2-3 calls per week in the interim since the last  
10          meeting..
- 11          •       Primary focus has been on cdma2000 Rev. D but DOAH also met.
- 12          •       A compromise proposal has been defined on timing issues.
- 13          •       Attempting to make decisions this week that will allow WG2 to begin  
14          their work.
- 15          •       No report from WG4.
- 16 11.    OLD BUSINESS:
- 17          •       A contribution on dedicated mode BCMCS (C00-20030818-014) was presented  
18          by CCSA on behalf of five (5) additional contributors. **ACTION: This**  
19          **contribution was remanded to WG2 and WG3 for review and action as**  
20          **appropriate.**
- 21 12.    ITU PROCESS/APPROVAL: The WG3 ITU AdHoc Chair, Ron Ferguson (Sprint PCS),  
22          indicated that an overview section for M.1457 must be submitted and a preliminary  
23          version of the 3GPP2 specification documents that are intended to be included in this  
24          update must be submitted by 24 September 2003 as Global Core Specifications. His  
25          assumption is that these documents can be baseline text documents. Based on this  
26          definition and the 24 September 2003 deadline, TSG-C may not be able to submit either  
27          cdma2000 Rev. D or HRPD Rev. A since baseline text status is unlikely. However, the  
28          discussion noted that TSG-C can approve documents for delivery to ITU that are not  
29          baseline text status. The understanding of the group was as noted below:
- 30          •       The overview section, once submitted, cannot be changed. The documents  
31          described in that overview must be documents that will be transposed and  
32          published by at least one (1) of the 3GPP2 SDOs on or before 31 May 2004.
- 33          •       A version of the specifications referenced by that overview section that is  
34          approved for transmission by TSG-C must be submitted on 24 September 2003  
35          for the GCS. The definition of the requirements of this submission were unclear.
- 36          **ACTION: The ITU AdHoc was remanded the task to clarify all issues raised in the**  
37          **discussion, with the intent of releasing both cdma2000 Rev. D and HRPD Rev. A,**  
38          **for consideration at the closing Plenary.**

1 13. NEW BUSINESS: No contributions.

2 This session was recessed on 18 August 2003 at 12:30 PM local time.

3

#### 4 CLOSING PLENARY

5 The meeting was reconvened on 22 August 2003 at 7:15 AM local time.

6 Quorum was established at the opening Plenary and not challenged at this time. One (1)  
7 additional 3GPP2 member company was noted in attendance.

8 9. LIAISON REPORTS (continued):

9 • TSG-S: A TSG-S Liaison Report (C00-200300818-105) was presented by the  
10 TSG-S Liaison, Clif Barber (KDDI), as FYI.

11 Included this report was a recommendation from the TSG-S OMA AdHoc to  
12 initiate TSG-C review of the OMA LS on DRM in anticipation of SC  
13 authorization for an official liaison relationship and in an attempt to respond in  
14 time for the next OMA meeting in Berlin in September 2003.

15 • **ACTION: The TSG-S Document Status Table (C00-200300818-106)**  
16 **was remanded to WG1 as FYI.**

17 • Correspondence dated 21 August 2003 to all TSGs regarding initiation of  
18 V&V for S.P0038-0 v1.1.7 3GPP2 Evolution document (C00-200300818-  
19 105) was presented from TSG-S. **ACTION: This contribution was**  
20 **remanded to WG1, WG2, and WG3 for review and comment with**  
21 **comments to be coordinated by WG1.**

22 • Correspondence dated 21 August 2003 to 3GPP2 SC Chair and 3GPP2  
23 Secretariat regarding updated TSG-S OMA AdHoc Report (C00-  
24 200300818-105) was presented from TSG-S. This contribution included a  
25 request to the SC to immediately approve a liaison relationship with OMA  
26 that would support the following:

- 27 • Authorization for 3GPP2 TSGs to review liaisons from OMA  
28 groups and make necessary responses.  
29 • Authorization for 3GPP2 TSGs to initiate liaison statements to  
30 OMA groups

31 All communication between 3GPP2 TSGs and OMA will be coordinated  
32 by a group to be designated by the SC (i.e., SC Delegate).

33 This contribution was considered to be FYI for the TSG.

34 • TSG-A: The following contributions were discussed:

35 • Correspondence dated 18 July 2003 to TSG-X regarding BCMCS  
36 Framework and Purge Service Bit for SO 60/61 (C00-200300818-108)  
37 was presented from TSG-A. Since the date for the referenced conference  
38 call had passed, this correspondence was noted as FYI to the TSG.

- Correspondence dated 21 August 2003 regarding information regarding Release D (C00-200300818-109) was presented from TSG-S. This correspondence request a tutorial on cdma2000 Release D to assist TSG-A in planning Release D support in their next version of the IOS. **ACTION: This contribution was remanded to WG1 and WG3 for review and comment. The requested tutorial will be coordinated by WG3.**

  - Received an updated framework document for C.P0045-0 baseline text from the Editor. No technical issues remain open. However, KDDI has expressed opposition to language regarding transcoding in Section 5.2 (Speech).
  - Approved SDO review text for C.P0048-0 v0.9 (ME Conformance Test).
  - Scheduled a WG1 teleconference for Wednesday, 10 September 2003 during the 5-6 PM CDT time period. The primary topic of discussion will be consideration of baseline text for C.P0016-C (OTASP Revision).
  - SWG1.2 reinitiated discussions on C.P0046-0 (Multimedia Streaming Service).
  - SWG1.2 accepted the resignation of Nikolai Leung (QUALCOMM) as Vice-Chair. Hari Garudadri (QUALCOMM) was appointed to replace him.
  - Completed V&V on C.P0048-0 (ME Conformance Test)

**DECISION: C.P9008 Video Conferencing - Packet Based was rescinded without objection.**

**DECISION: A new project designation for Packet Switched Video Conferencing Service was approved without objection. C.P0055-0 was assigned for Packet Switched Video Conferencing Service.**

A contribution on Release D vs C.P0017-A SDO review comment resolution (C00-20030818-112) was presented from WG1. This contribution indicated that the project objectives for TIA ballot resolution for C.P0017-A (ballot comments due on 4 September 2003) and cdma2000 Release D cannot be met at the same time since the same people participate in both SWG1.3 and SWG2.1. **DECISION: The Chair directed that the priority for meeting time in Calgary should be designated to SWG2.1. As such, TIA will be requested to extend the ballot response time for TIA-707-B for an additional month.**

**DECISION: Proposed correspondence to TSG-S regarding TSG-C Stage 1 review (C00-20030818-113) was approved without objection for transmission.**

**DECISION: Proposed correspondence to TSG-X regarding IETF dependencies (C00-20030818-114) was approved without objection for transmission.**

**DECISION: C.P0048-0 v0.9 ME Conformance Test proposed SDO review text (C00-20030818-115) was approved without objection for SDO review and comment including liaise to TR45.**

1       **DECISION: The TSG-C 2003 workplan v4 (C00-20030818-116) was adopted**  
2       **without objection.**

3       The TSG-C Document Catalog as of August 2003 (C00-20030818-117R1) was noted as  
4       FYI.

5       **DECISION: Proposed correspondence to ETSI SCP regarding UICC temperature**  
6       **range (C00-20030818-119) was approved without objection for forwarding to the SC**  
7       **Chair for transmission.**

8       **DECISION: C.P0045-0 v0.4 MMS Media Formats and Codecs (C00-20030818-118)**  
9       **was approved over the objection of KDDI as baseline text. ACTION: This**  
10       **contribution was remanded back to WG1 for V&V.**

- 11       •     WG2 REPORT: The WG2 report (C00-20030818-102) was presented by the WG2  
12       Chair, Orlett Pearson (Lucent), as FYI.
  - 13           •     Approved cdma2000 High Rate Broadcast-Multicast Packet Data Air Interface  
14           Specification (C.S0054) to be recommended for SDO review.
  - 15           •     Generated and approved correspondence to TSG-C on plus code dialing.
  - 16           •     Continued work on cdma2000 Release D upper layers.
  - 17           •     SWG2.5 also reviewed contribution on HRPD Rev. A, currently classified as FYI  
18           in that group.
  - 19           •     The interim WG2 conference call schedule was noted in the report.

20       **DECISION: Proposed correspondence to TSG-X regarding plus code dialing**  
21       **(C00-20030818-110) was approved without objection for transmission.**

22       **DECISION: C.P0054-0 v0.95 cdma2000 High Rate Broadcast Multicast Packet**  
23       **Data Air Interface (C00-20030818-111) was approved without objection for SDO**  
24       **review and comment including liaison to TR45.**

- 25       •     WG3 REPORT: The WG3 report (C00-20030818-103) was presented by the WG3  
26       Chair, Ed Tiedemann (QUALCOMM), as FYI.
  - 27           •     Most WG3 time this week was focused on cdma2000 Rev. D. Did get substantive  
28           agreements have been made on the relative to the reverse link including:

- 4                   •       A volunteer has begun the text development effort.
- 5                   •       Regarding HRPD Rev. A:
- 6                   •       Reached agreement on an HRPD Rev. A development schedule
- 7                   •       DOAH completed their charter and has been disbanded. Future HRPD  
8                   Rev. A discussions will be held at the WG3 level and will be led by Jun Li  
9                   (Nortel Networks).
- 10                  •       The ITU AdHoc submitted a plan to submit both cdma2000 Rev. D and HRPD  
11                  Rev. A as ITU-R WP 8F updates in September 2003.
- 12                  •       The interim WG3 conference call schedule was noted in the report.

13                  **DECISION: The RSPC update package (C00-20030818-103A) and the associated**  
14                  **letters to be submitted by the 3GPP2 SDOs (C00-20030818-103B) were conditionally**  
15                  **approved for transmission to ITU-R WP 8F and to the 3GPP2 OPs pending possible**  
16                  **changes that are submitted to and consolidated by the WG3 ITU AdHoc Chair, Ron**  
17                  **Ferguson (Sprint PCS). This information will be transmitted to the 3GPP2 OPs on**  
18                  **29 August 2003. ACTION: TSG participants were directed to review the proposed**  
19                  **ITU submission material and provide comments to the WG3 ITU AdHoc Chair,**  
20                  **Ron Ferguson (Sprint PCS), in time for him to forward comments on 29 August**  
21                  **2003.**

1 The HRPD Rev. A development schedule for WG3 (C00-20030818-103C) was  
 2 presented. During the discussion on work schedules, Nokia suggested that the TSG focus  
 3 its activities on the completion of cdma2000 Rev. D and delay work on HRPD Rev. A  
 4 until after October. ALLTEL stated their support for the Nokia proposal. The Chair  
 5 proposed, as a compromise, that the HRPD action to “make some decisions” be deleted  
 6 from the September actions. All key decisions would then be made in October 2003.  
 7 The WG3 Chair agreed that the Chair’s compromise was a reasonable suggestion.

8 The following additional items were decided:

- 9 • **DECISION: An WG3 conference call was scheduled for 28 August 2003, in**  
 10 **addition to the conference calls already planned by WG2 and documented in**  
 11 **the WG3 Report.**
- 12 • **DECISION: The WG3 HRPD Rev. A schedule (C00-20030818-103C) was**  
 13 **noted as having been received by the Plenary with the deletion of the action**  
 14 **to “make some decisions” from September.** The Chair will now combine this  
 15 schedule with the WG2 schedule accepted at the last meeting into a single HRPD  
 16 schedule for the TSG.
- 17 • **WG4 REPORT:** The WG4 report (C00-20030818-104) was presented by SWG4.2 Chair,  
 18 Kurt Bantle (Spirent), as FYI.
  - 19 • Responded to WG1 regarding UICC temperature issues.
  - 20 • DV MPS schedules may slip again based on resource limitations of companies  
 21 involved in the cdma2000 Rev. D development. A proposal has been made to  
 22 delay the delivery deadline from December 2003 to June 2004. Both Nokia and  
 23 TI commented on the importance of this release and their concerns regarding the  
 24 potential delay. Those companies were requested to participate in upcoming  
 25 SWG4.1 conference calls in an attempt to resolve this issue.
  - 26 • Work continues on C.P0043 Signaling Conformance Spec and C.P0044  
 27 Interoperability Spec.

28 No actions required from Plenary.

29 11. OLD BUSINESS (continued):

- 30 • **ACTION: The Liaison Statement regarding DRM Content Format**  
 31 **Statement (C00-20030714-015) was remanded to WG1 for review and action**  
 32 **as appropriate pending SC authorization for OMA liaison activity.**
