1 During the period of 23-27 August 2004, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Osaka
2 International Convention Center in Osaka, Japan. This document is intended to summarize those
3 proceedings.

5 OPENING PLENARY

6 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order at
7 8:45 AM local time on 23 August 2004 by TSG-C Chair, BK Yi (LGE).

8 The Chair welcomed everyone to Osaka, Japan and thanked TTC for their efforts in
9 hosting this meeting. The Secretary provided logistics information related to the
10 facilities and events for the week.

11 The Chair announced that the primary TSG-C objective for this week was to clear the
12 backlog of contributions for the last meeting.

13 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of companies
14 indicated that 20 companies included on the list of 27 quorum members were present
15 (74% participation).

16 The Secretary noted that one (1) proxy statement had been received as follows: TI has
17 designated their proxy to Nokia.

18 3. INTRODUCTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were
19 loaded onto the 3GPP2 LAN server and listed in the document register (C00-
20 20040823-000R2).

21 4. AGENDA APPROVAL: The proposed agenda (C00-20040823-001R2) was presented.
22 **DECISION: The agenda was approved without objection as submitted (C00-
23 20040823-001R2).**

24 5. ASSIGNMENTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO AGENDA ITEMS: Contributions were
25 assigned to agenda items as noted on the agenda.

26 6. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY: The summary of the TSG-C
27 meeting for July 2004 that was held in Los Angeles, CA, USA (C00-20040823-002) was
28 presented. **DECISION: This meeting summary was approved without objection as
29 submitted (C00-20040823-002).**

30 7. REVIEW OF OUTSTANDING ACTIONS FROM PREVIOUS MEETING: The action
