2 Clearwater Beach Resort in Clearwater, FL, USA. This document is intended to summarize those

## 5 OPENING PLENARY

6 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order at  
7 8:45 AM local time on 18 October 2004 by TSG-C Chair, BK Yi (LGE).

8 The Chair welcomed everyone to Clearwater, FL. He expressed hope that the week  
9 would not be encumbered by any hurricanes and encouraged everyone to view the  
10 beaches in the area.

11 The Chair noted his plan to process the contributions and announced that an overview of  
12 the 3GPP2 QoS system on Tuesday from 3:00 to 5:00 PM.

13 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of companies  
14 indicated that 24 companies included on the list of 27 quorum members were present  
15 (89% participation).

16 The Secretary noted that no proxy statements had been received.
