1 During the period of 20-24 February 2006, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Jeju Shilla  
2 Hotel in Jeju, Korea. This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

6 20 February 2006 at 8:31 AM local time by TSG-C Chair, BK Yi (LGE).
