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18 **Abstract:**

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19 This document is a summary of the 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings that were held during the period of  
20 31 March – 3 April 2008 in Montreal, QC, Canada.

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1 During the period of 31 March – 3 April 2008, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Delta Centre-  
2 Ville in Montreal, QC, Canada. This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

#### 4 OPENING PLENARY

5 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on 31 March  
6 2008 at 8:58 AM local time by TSG-C Chair, Dennis Gentzler (Alltel).

7 The Chair welcomed everyone to Montreal, Canada. He also thanked TSG-C Vice Chair,  
8 Soonyil Kwon (LGE) for chairing the Xiamen meetings in his absence.

9 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of companies indicated that  
10 22 companies included on the list of 30 active quorum members were present (73%  
11 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved.

12 The Secretary noted that no proxy statements had been received for this meeting.

13 3. INTRODUCTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were loaded  
14 onto the 3GPP2 LAN server and listed in the document register (C00-20080331- 000).

15 4. AGENDA APPROVAL: The proposed agenda (C00-20080331-001R1) was presented.

16 **DECISION: The agenda was approved without objection as modified by the discussion**  
17 **(C00-2008331-001R1).**

18 The WG3 Chair noted that the FCC quiet period for 700 MHz will extend until 6:00 PM on  
19 Thursday so 700 MHz will not be discussed during this meeting cycle.

20 The Secretary noted the following activities for the week:

16 **DECISION: Parag Agashe (Qualcomm) was confirmed as the new SWG2.2 Vice**  
17 **Chair.**

18 080218-01 The contribution regarding Comments and Questions for UMB Document  
19 Structure proposal from WG1 (C00-20080218-124) was held OPEN at the Plenary level  
20 for further consideration.

21 **ACTION: This contribution was remanded to all WGs for review and comment**  
22 **with comments to be coordinated by WG2 with the intent to resolve all open issues**  
23 **by closing Plenary on Thursday evening.**

24 8. LIAISON REPORTS:

7           Based on this notice, the SC Chair stated the workshop to start on Friday 16 May 2008 at  
8           10:00 AM. The Secretariat has been requested to confirm that meeting rooms will be  
9           available into the evening. However, the Chair indicated that he could not commit that  
10           TSG-C business would be completed by the 10:00 AM target as progress would be  
11           dictated by completion of work within the working groups, but would attempt to take  
12           measures to support the Workshop.
