1 During the period of 12-15 May 2008, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Hotel New Otani Osaka
2 in Osaka, Japan. This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

4 OPENING PLENARY

5 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on 12 May
6 2008 at 8:52 AM local time by TSG-C Chair, Dennis Gentzler (Alltel).

7 The Chair welcomed everyone to Osaka, Japan. The Chair requested all participants to sign in
8 on the 3GPP2 LAN.

9 Vice-Chair, Yoshinori Ishikawa (Hitachi), reminded the participants of the TSG-C Team
10 building event that was scheduled for Wednesday starting at 6:30 PM. The meeting invitation
11 was loaded onto the server.

12 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of companies indicated that
13 18 companies included on the list of 29 active quorum members were present (62%
14 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved.

15 The Secretary noted that no proxy statements had been received for this meeting.

28 factor to be used.
 - 29 • It was confirmed that we do not have to update the excel spreadsheets
30 which capture all the simulation results from companies even if some
31 companies update their results, because we have already confirmed that
32 we are aligned.
 - 33 • It was decided to keep open the updated text on the EMD (C30-20080512-
34 016A) for one month to review. It was also decided to change the title of
35 the EMD from "cdma2000 Evaluation Methodology" to "Air Interface
36 Evaluation Methodology," because this document covers not only
37 cdma2000 but also OFDMA-based air interfaces.
 - 38 • WG3 received one contribution on TDD at the meeting. Note that the deadline
39 for component proposal submittals is the June meeting.
 - 40 • Working Group 3 conducted R&F on the position location pilot (HDP). R&F has
41 now been completed. Working Group 3 requests approval for V&V. V&V
42 comments should be returned before the July meeting, preferably by July 16th.
