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9 **Abstract:**

10 This document provides the summary of the 3GPP2 TSG-S meetings held at the Osaka International
11 Conference Center in Osaka, Japan during the period of 29-31 January 2001.

1 During the period of 29-31 January 2001, a meeting of 3GPP2 TSG-S was held at the Osaka
2 International Conference Center in Osaka, Japan. This report is intended to summarize those
3 discussions.

4 OPENING PLENARY

5 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on
6 29 January 2001 at 8:55 AM local time by TSG-S Chair, Hideo Okinaka (KDDI).

7 The Chair welcomed everyone to Osaka, the second largest city in Japan.

8 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of TSG-S active
9 companies indicated 15 companies in attendance out of 16 active companies (94%
10 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved.

11 3. DISTRIBUTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were
12 documented in S00-20010129-000R1. All contributions were distributed as soft copy only.

13 4. ADOPTION OF AGENDA: The proposed agenda (S00-20010129-001R1) was reviewed
14 and approved without objection as modified by the discussion (S00-20010129-001R2).

15 5. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO AGENDA ITEMS: The contributions were
16 numbered and assigned to agenda items.

17 6. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY: The meeting
18 summary for December 2000 in Kauai, HI (S00-20010129-002) was presented and approved
19 without objection as submitted.

20 7. CORRESPONDENCE: All correspondence were assigned to the applicable agenda item.

21 8. LIAISON REPORTS

22 • E-mail correspondence dated 9 January 2001 from the 3GPP2 Secretariat (S00-
23 20010129-028) was presented indicating that the following documents had passed the
24 15 day approval period and were considered to be official 3GPP2 documents.

1 Action on these documents was deferred until the appropriate agenda item.

2 • TSG-A:

3 • The draft meeting summary of the TSG-A meeting in Kauai in December 2000
4 (S00-20010129-016) was presented by the TSG-A Chair. The following
5 items were noted:

- 6 • IOS v4.1 (A.S0001-A) was approved for publication and forwarded
7 to the 3GPP2 Secretariat.
- 8 • The TFO specification bug fix addendum (A.S0004-0.1) had all ballot
9 comments resolved and was approved for publication.

10 As a result of the discussion related to the questions on 1xEV-DO which were
11 distributed to all TSGs, WG1 was reminded that they must have a TSG-S
12 response for TSG-A by closing Plenary.

13 • The draft meeting summary of the TSG-A meeting in Kauai in December 2000
14 (S00-20010129-032) was presented by the TSG-A Chair. The following TSG
15 leadership was confirmed for the next term:

- 16 • CHAIR: George Turnipseed (Sprint PCS)
- 17 • VICE CHAIR: Naoto Ito (KDDI)
- 18 • VICE CHAIR: Sung Kim (SK Telecom)

19 • TSG-C: The TSG-C Liaison Report (S00-20010129-004) indicated the following:

20 • The incumbent TSG leadership was reconfirmed for the next term including the
21 following:

- 22 • CHAIR: Jean Alphonse (Lucent)
- 23 • VICE CHAIR: Sang-Uoon Chung (Samsung)
- 24 • VICE CHAIR: Kazuto Miyazaki (Motorola Japan)

25 • The TSG-C comments on the 3GPP2 Workplan v22 (S00-20010129-005)
26 was presented and remanded to PMT for review and action as appropriate.

27 • The new TSG-C workplan including the results of all reorganizing activities
28 (S00-20010129-006) was presented and remanded to PMT for review and
29 action as appropriate.

- 1 • TSG-N:
- 2 • The TSG-N Liaison Report for December 2000 (S00-20010129-023) was
3 presented by Lucent on behalf of the TSG-N Liaison as FYI. Although the
4 report indicated that the following correspondences to TSG-S had been
5 approved at that meeting, those correspondences have not been received by
6 TSG-S:
- 7 • Letter to TSG-S requesting additional information on the IS-2000
8 Handoff and requesting involvement in any forthcoming discussions.
- 9 • Letter to TSG-S agreeing with joint ownership of Stage 1 documents.
- 10 In addition, although the report indicated that TSG-N recommended that TR45
11 take responsibility for assigning UIM ID numbers, the actual correspondence
12 indicated only that the 3GPP2 process be tightly coordinated with TR45.
- 13 The report indicated also that two (2) TSG-N correspondences to TSG-S had
14 been approved but were not received by TSG-S. The TSG-N Liaison will be
15 queried by the WG1 Chair to determine the status of those correspondences.
- 16 • The TSG-N Liaison Report for January 2000 (S00-20010129-024) was
17 presented by Lucent on behalf of the TSG-N Liaison as FYI. This report
18 indicated the following TSG-N leadership for the next term:
- 19 • CHAIR: Betsy Kidwell (Lucent)
- 20 • VICE CHAIR: Hee Joung Lee (LGE)
- 21 • TSG-P: No report.
- 22 • QoS JEM: Discussions deferred to the New Business agenda item.
- 23 • TR45: Cheryl Blum (Lucent) has been confirmed as the new TR45 Chair and was also
24 appointed as the new TIA Head of Delegation to 3GPP2.
- 25 • TR45 ISD ADHOC: No report.
- 26 • TR45 NAG: No report.
- 27 • TR45 AHAG: Verbal report was provided by the AHAG Liaison as FYI.
- 28 • Nearing approval of 3G to 2G key scheme. Currently working on 2G to 3G
29 scheme.
- 30 • Review of TSG-S correspondence is still in process.
- 31 • 3GPP-SA5: No report.
- 32 • TIM1: No report.
- 33 • CDG: No report.

- 1 • MWIF: An MWIF status report (S00-20010129-031) was presented by the Vice
2 Chair, Rich Robinson (Sprint PCS), as FYI. This report indicated the following:
- 3 • Working draft of RAN architecture and final operator requirements in
4 January 2001.
- 5 • Completion of RAN architecture targeted for April 2001
- 6 • Core network recommendations to 3GPP2 to be completed in July 2001.
- 7 • Final RAN and NRA recommendations due in October 2001.
- 8 • WAP FORUM: An unofficial report was presented verbally by the All IP AdHoc
9 Chair as FYI. WAP Forum is currently working to make terminology compatible with
10 IETF. Participation from cdma2000 shareholders has increased.
- 11 • ITU: A contribution entitled "ITU-T Special Study Group on "IMT-2000 and
12 Beyond"" (S00-20010129-033R1) was presented by Nortel Networks as FYI.

13 9. NEW BUSINESS

- 14 • NOMINATIONS FOR LEADERSHIP FOR THE NEW TERM
- 15 • The Chair noted that a single nomination for TSG-S Chair had been submitted
16 to date. That nomination was for Rich Robinson (Sprint PCS). A letter of
17 nomination and support from Sprint PCS (S00-20010129-010) was noted and
18 hard copy was also provided to the Secretary.
- 19 • The Chair noted that Wan Yi (CWTS) had been nominated for TSG-S Vice
20 Chair and a letter of nomination (S00-20010129-011) was noted. There were
21 two (2) concerns expressed regarding this nomination:
- 22 • The letter received did not qualify as a letter of support from his
23 company as required by 3GPP2 rules.
- 24 • The candidate did not represent a 3GPP2 member company. CWTS is
25 an observer at the TSG level and the MII - RITT division (Mr. Yi's
26 employer) is also not an active 3GPP2 member.
- 27 The Secretary was directed to communicate to the candidate that, based on the
28 concerns expressed, that further clarification was required to qualify this
29 individual as a candidate by the closing Plenary.
- 30 • The Chair noted that a nomination had been received from KDDI for Akira
31 Matsunaga as TSG-S Vice Chair. A letter of support from KDDI
32 (S00-20010129-014) was noted and hard copy was also provided to the
33 Secretary.

34 The Chair then reminded the participants that the election for Chair would be held at an
35 Interim Plenary on 30 January 2001 and that the elections for Vice Chair would be held
36 at the closing Plenary on 31 January 2001. He also noted that, in compliance with
37 3GPP2 rules, nominations may still be submitted up until the actual election.

- 1 • Correspondence dated 19 January 2001 from TSG-A to TSG-P regarding Fast
2 Handoff Support (S00-20010129- 030) was presented as FYI. This contribution
3 indicated a concern regarding the possible need for coordination with other TSGs which
4 has not been addressed by TSG-P. This correspondence was remanded to the PMT
5 for review and action as required by the closing Plenary.
- 6 • The Chair noted that all TSGs were remanded by the SC the task of reviewing their
7 terms of reference based on the activation of the All IP development activity. This task
8 of reviewing the TSG-S terms of reference was remanded to all WGs. The WG
9 outputs will then be consolidated by the Secretary for review and approval at the
10 closing Plenary.
- 11 • A Liaison Statement on the Smart Card Applications Toolkit (CAT) which was sent to
12 3GPP, 3GPP2 TSG-C, CDG, TIA TR45, and other groups (S00-20010129-018)
13 was presented by Gemplus. This Liaison Statement included basic assumptions to be
14 used in the development of CAT which were primarily based on GSM. The 3GPP
15 specification on Smart Cards: Card Application Toolkit (3GPP TS 102 CAT)
16 (S00-20010129-017) was also noted. This document was remanded to WG1 for
17 review and comment on these assumptions and to PMT for consideration for addition to
18 the 3GPP2 Workplan as a new work item.
- 19 • The meeting summary from the QoS JEM which was held in Kansas City, MO during
20 the period of 24-25 January 2001 (S00-20010129-008) was presented and reviewed
21 in detail by the Secretary. This document was remanded to WGs as FYI.
- 22 • The QoS JEM Output (S00-20010129-009) was presented and reviewed in detail by
23 the QoS JEM Chair. This contribution included attachments with additional technical
24 and workplan recommendations for consideration. The JEM Output included the
25 following information:
- 26 • Requirements
- 27 • Technical/design issues
- 28 • Workplan issues
- 29 This contribution also included the following recommendations:
- 30 • SHORT TERM: Focus on specification of end-to-end (i.e., application to
31 application) QoS for background, interactive, and streaming classes of service
32 in the legacy architecture by the end of year 2001. However, it is noted that
33 TSG-N support for this effort in the given timeframe is still to be determined.
- 34 • LONG TERM: End-to-end QoS support must be included in the All IP
35 development activities for both the legacy and multimedia domains. The TSG-S
36 All IP AdHoc is responsible for coordinating that effort.

1 This contribution was remanded to all WGs for review and comment by closing Plenary
2 with the intent of establishing a TSG-S position at that time for submission to the SC
3 meeting on 1 February 2001.

4 10. OLD BUSINESS:

5 • WG1 ISSUES

- 6 • E-mail correspondence dated 25 December 2001 from NEC regarding their
7 concerns related to final acceptance of S.R0007 USCF Stage 1
8 (S00-20010129-012) was presented. This correspondence noted format
9 problems in that document. An updated S.R0007 Stage 1 to address the
10 concerns (S00-20010129-019) was noted from KDDI and NEC. Both
11 documents were remanded to WG1 for review and action as appropriate.
- 12 • TR45.2 comments on the S.P0020 LIR Stage 1 (S00-20010129-021) were
13 presented. This contribution was remanded to WG1 for response by closing
14 Plenary.
- 15 • E-mail correspondence from the Secretary regarding confusion over the
16 nomenclature of S.R0023 1xEV-DO (i.e., S.R0023-A v1.0 vs S.R0023 v2.0)
17 was presented. The Secretary recommended reconfirmation of this document
18 as S.R0023 v2.0. This recommendation was adopted without objection and
19 the Secretary was directed to notify the 3GPP2 Secretariat to release the
20 document immediately as approved.
- 21 • Correspondence dated 15 December 2000 from TSG-N regarding questions
22 for clarification of requirements specified in S.R0023 1xEV-DO
23 (S00-20010129-025) was presented. This contribution was remanded to
24 WG1 for review and response by closing Plenary.
- 25 • The S.P0029 ACCT Stage 1 (S00-20010129-022) was presented by the
26 WG1 Chair. This document had been approved by WG1 pending inclusion of
27 directed changes. The WG1 Chair indicated that the contribution had been
28 broadcast on the TSG-S exploder one (1) week in advance on this meeting for
29 review and comment and no comments had been received. The TSG approved
30 this document as S.R0029 v1.0 without objection for publication.
- 31 • Comments on TSG-S ESA-ESP Stage 1 Description (S00-20010129-020)
32 were presented by Lucent. This contribution was remanded to WG1 for review
33 and action as appropriate.
- 34 • Correspondence dated 14 December 2000 from TR45.2 regarding their status
35 on review of S.R0032 ESA-ESP Stage 1 (S00-20010129-027) was
36 presented. This contribution was remanded to WG1 for review and action as
37 appropriate by the closing Plenary.

- 1 • A proposed Stage 1 for MEID (S00-20010129-003) was presented jointly by
2 Motorola and Nokia. This contribution was remanded to WG1 for review and
3 action as appropriate.
- 4 • W2 ISSUES: Correspondence dated 11 January 2001 from T1M1 to 3GPP SA5
5 regarding coordination between 3GPP and T1M1 on CORBA based fault management
6 and performance monitoring work efforts. This contribution was remanded to WG2 for
7 review and action as appropriate.
- 8 • PMT ISSUES: No additional contributions.
- 9 • ALL IP ADHOC:
- 10 • The All IP AdHoc meeting summary for January 2001 (S00-20010129-015)
11 was noted as FYI.
- 12 • The All IP Status Report for January 2001 (S00-20010129-007) was
13 presented by the All IP AdHoc Chair. The document summarizes the status of
14 the AdHoc after their initial meeting. Attachments to this document included the
15 following:
- 16 • Meeting organization (S00-20010129-007A)
17 • AdHoc priorities (S00-20010129-007B)
18 • Project Documents (S00-20010129-007C)
19 • Open Items List v1.4 (S00-20010129-007D)
- 20 Regarding the meeting organization, the group agreed that the All IP AdHoc
21 would meet in series with the TSG-S WGs when the groups are collocated in
22 March. At that time, the issue of parallel meetings will be considered as
23 necessary.
- 24 The All IP AdHoc has recommended the concept of a Project Description
25 document which is a high-end specification of the end-to-end system which
26 would be generated by the AdHoc. All TSGs are requested to comment on
27 this concept by the next meeting. The task of recommending a TSG position on
28 this subject was remanded to the PMT for action by the closing Plenary.
- 29 The group agreed to submit the All IP Status Report (S00-20010129-007) to
30 the SC for presentation. The decision on whether or not to include any
31 attachments was deferred to the closing Plenary.
- 32 • V&V REPORT: No report.
- 33 • HEADER COMPRESSION FOR MULTIMEDIA SERVICES: The Chair noted that
34 a contribution on a proposed Stage 1 for Header Compression which was received at
35 closing Plenary of the last meeting and was carried forward to this meeting (S00-
36 20001205-060) was remanded to WG1 for review and action as appropriate.
- 37 • V&V ISSUES: No issues discussed.

- 1 • UIM ISSUES: Correspondence dated 15 December 2001 to the SC Chair from
2 TSG-N regarding UIM ID issues as remanded by the SC (S00-20010129-026) was
3 noted as FYI. Gemplus made a statement of concerns regarding some of the issues
4 raised by the TSG-N position statement and the general delay in achieving a 3GPP2
5 solution.
- 6 • LOCATION/TIERED SERVICES: No issues discussed.

7 The Plenary was recessed at 1:40 PM local time.

8

9 INTERIM PLENARY

10 The Plenary was reconvened at 4:30 PM local time on 30 January 2001 by TSG-S Chair, Hideo
11 Okinaka (KDDI). Quorum had been established at the opening Plenary and was not challenged at this
12 session. No additional companies were added to the attendance list.

13 11. ELECTION OF TSG CHAIR

14 The Chair indicated that the only candidate for TSG-S Chair that had been nominated to date
15 was Rich Robinson (Sprint PCS). The Chair then asked if there were any additional
16 nominations and none were noted. The Chair then closed the nominations. Rich Robinson
17 (Sprint PCS) was then approved without objection as TSG-S Chair for the next term.

18 There Chair also indicated that there were still only two (2) announced candidates for the
19 position of Vice Chair but that nominations for that position were still open until the time of the
20 election at closing Plenary.

21 The Secretary noted that he had received additional correspondence from MII-RITT on behalf
22 of Mr. Wan Yi (S00-20010129-011R1) that does satisfy the 3GPP2 requirements as a letter
23 of support from his company. The issue of his representation of an active individual member
24 company of 3GPP2 is still outstanding.

25 The Plenary was recessed at 4:40 PM local time.

26

27 CLOSING PLENARY

28 The Plenary was reconvened at 3:15 PM local time on 31 January 2001 by TSG-S Chair, Hideo
29 Okinaka (KDDI). Quorum had been established at the opening Plenary and was not challenged at this
30 session. One (1) additional 3GPP2 member company was noted in attendance.

1 12. ELECTION OF TSG VICE CHAIRS

2 The Secretary noted the additional correspondence from CWTS regarding the candidacy of
3 Mr. Wan Yi (S00-20010129-011R2) which noted the withdrawal of his candidacy for TSG-S
4 Vice Chair and his nomination for the position of SC Vice Chair.

5 The Chair noted that the sole remaining candidate for the position of Vice Chair was Akira
6 Matsunaga (KDDI). The Chair asked if there were any additional candidates for that position
7 and none were noted. Mr. Matsunaga was confirmed as the TSG-S Vice Chair without
8 objection.

9 The Chair also noted that the remaining TSG-S Vice Chair position would remain open pending
10 any additional nominations in the future.

11 13. WORKING GROUP REPORTS

- 12 • WG1 Report (S00-20010129-041R1) was presented by WG1 Chair, Nick
13 Mazzarella (Lucent) as FYI.
- 14 • Based on review of preliminary list of All IP features, determined the need for a
15 Stage 1 style sheet document. Clif Barber (Oki Network Technologies)
16 assigned to prepare a draft and broadcast on the TSG-S exploder for comment
17 before the March 2001 meeting.
- 18 • All IP AdHoc must submit a list of All IP Stage 1 descriptions which will be
19 required at the next meeting.
- 20 • QoS Stage 1 objectives will be prepared by Cathy Fitzpatrick (Lucent) by the
21 next meeting.
- 22 • A draft of the MEID Stage 1 will be liaised to TR45 UIM-ESN AdHoc for
23 comment by the Editor, Scott Migaldi (Motorola).
- 24 • Work on the IP Broadcast/Multicast Stage 1 was reactivated. Mark Lipford
25 (Sprint PCS) was assigned as the Editor.

26 Correspondence to TSG-P regarding prepaid charging is still under consideration by
27 TSG-P. PMT must make a determination on whether this feature will be a part of
28 Release C for the Legacy Network and/or the All IP Network before TSG-P can
29 respond.

30 Correspondence to TR45.2 in response to their comments on the LIR Stage 1
31 comments (S00-20010129-053) was presented. This correspondence was approved
32 without objection for transmission as modified by the discussion (S00-20010129-
33 053R1) with the associated attachment.

34 Correspondence to TSG-A regarding their inquiries related to 1xEV-DO issues (S00-
35 20010129-050) was presented. This correspondence was approved without objection
36 for transmission as modified by the discussion (S00-20010129-050R1).

1 Correspondence to TSG-N and TSG-C regarding Gemplus contributions on Smart
2 Cards: CAT (S00-20010129-047R1) was presented. This correspondence was
3 approved without objection for transmission as modified by the discussion (S00-
4 20010129-047R2).

5 S.R0007 USCF Stage 1 v2.1 (S00-20010129-051) was presented including all format
6 changes identified during the 15-day approval process. This contribution was approved
7 without objection for publication. The 3GPP2 Secretariat will be requested to
8 immediately post this document as approved.

9 Correspondence to TR45.2 and TR45 AHAG regarding comments on S.R0032
10 ESA-ESP Stage 1 (S00-20010129-046) was presented. This correspondence was
11 approved without objection for transmission as modified by the discussion (S00-
12 20010129-046R1).

13 Correspondence to TSG-P and TSG-C regarding Header Compression for Multimedia
14 (S00-20010129-048) was presented. This correspondence was approved without
15 objection for transmission as modified by the discussion (S00-20010129-048R1).

16 The revised TSG-S Terms of Reference (S00-20010129-049) was presented. These
17 terms had been updated but no changes were required with respect to the All IP
18 development effort. This contribution was adopted without objection as submitted.
19 These Terms of Reference will be forwarded to the SC for approval.

- 20 • WG2 Report (S00-20010129-042) was presented by the WG2 Chair, Masaaki
21 Yoshimura (Hitachi) as FYI.
 - 22 • Reviewed correspondence between T1M1 and 3GPP on CORBA based fault
23 management. Determined that there was no impact to 3GPP2.
 - 24 • Continued work on the unified 3G OAM&P.
 - 25 • The WG2 Chair confirmed his intent to resign as of the next meeting.
- 26 • PMT Report (verbal report) was presented by PMT Chair, Bob Plunkett (Quicksilver)
27 as FYI.
 - 28 • Reviewed the 3GPP2 Workplan and incorporated the inputs from TSG-C and
29 the All IP AdHoc.
 - 30 • Discussed TSG coordination issues to be presented at the upcoming SC
31 meeting.
 - 32 • Reviewed Stage 1 development procedures but delayed action to insure
33 consistency with language agreed to in the TSG coordination summary.

34 The 3GPP2 Workplan v23 (S00-20010129-055) and the 3GPP2 Work Item
35 Descriptions (S00-20010129-056) were presented. The workplan was modified
36 editorially (S00-20010129-055R1) by the discussion. These documents were
37 approved without objection.

1 The work item description of CAT (S00-20010129-054) was noted as FYI since that
2 description was already included in the 3GPP2 Work Item Descriptions.

3 Action on determining the TSG-S position on the All IP Project Description was
4 deferred until the next meeting. The PMT Chair suggested consideration of
5 incorporating that information into the 3GPP2 System Capability Guide.

- 6 • V&V Report: No report.
- 7 • All IP AdHoc: No report.

8 14. OLD BUSINESS (continued): None additional.

9 15. NEW BUSINESS (continued): None additional.

10 16. ASSIGNMENTS: Not separately discussed.

24 Team prior to the opening Plenary at the next meeting.
