1 During the period of 3-6 December 2001, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Outrigger Wailea
2 Hotel in Maui HI. This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

3 OPENING PLENARY

4 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on
5 3 December 2001 at 2:15 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Rich Robinson (Sprint PCS).

6 The Chair welcomed everyone to Maui.

7 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of TSG-S active
8 companies indicated 15 companies in attendance out of 19 active companies (79%
9 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved. Sign-in of individual attendees was
10 accomplished via electronic sign-in on a file on the server.

11 3. DISTRIBUTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were
12 documented in S00-20011203-000. All contributions were distributed as soft copy only and
13 were made available from the server.

14 4. ADOPTION OF AGENDA: The proposed agenda (S00-20011203-001) was reviewed and
15 approved without objection as modified to include the contribution number assignments

16 5. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY: The meeting notes
17 for October 2001 in Shenzhen, China (S00-20011203-002) were presented. **DECISION:**
18 **This meeting summary was approved without objection for content accuracy. They**
19 **were also approved for release as the official meeting summary pending update of**

- 15 The proposed scope and charter this AdHoc was also included as an attachment
- 16 (S00-20011203- 003A). Draft correspondence over the signature of 3GPP2 SC
- 17 Chair to SDO leaders of this industry inviting them to the MEID JEM
- 18 (S00-20011203-004) .
- 19 The group felt that the purpose and the objectives of the JEM need additional
- 20 refinement and a small team of individuals agreed to discuss these concerns with the
- 21 target to release the JEM invitations this week.
- 22 • An update of the IP-based Location Services Stage 1 (S00-20011203-005) was
- 23 presented by QUALCOMM. **ACTION: This contribution was remanded to**
- 24 **WG1, WG2, and WG4 for review and action as appropriate.**
- 25 • A contribution on Stage 2 specification development process (S00-20011203-029)
- 26 was presented by QUALCOMM. This contribution proposes a process to coordinate
- 27 Stage 2 development among multiple TSGs. **ACTION: This contribution was**
- 28 **remanded to WG2 and the PMT for review and action as appropriate.**

9 was presented by QUALCOMM. This contribution recommended the
10 incorporation of three (3) items into the introductory sections of the Stage 1
11 templates to be used in future Stage 1 development activities. **ACTION: This**
12 **contribution was remanded to the PMT for review and action as**
13 **appropriate. In addition, all TSG-S participants were requested to**
14 **review this contribution for discussion at the closing Plenary.**
- 15 • Contribution S00-20011203-026 on Push Services Stage 1 was withdrawn
16 and will be submitted to WG1 directly.
- 17 • **ACTION: The TSG-S Chair and the WG1 Chair reiterated their**
18 **request for candidates for the position of WG1 Vice Chairs. The need is**
19 **immediate.**
- 20 • W2 ISSUES: The Chair advised that only a single candidate had submitted his name
21 for the position as the new WG2 Chair. Based on his expertise and success as Chair of
22 the TSG-S All IP AdHoc, Mark Lipford (Sprint PCS) was appointed as the WG2
23 Chair. **ACTION: The TSG-S Chair requested candidates for the WG2 Vice**
24 **Chair positions.**
- 25 • PMT ISSUES: No additional issues were noted.
- 26 • WG4 ISSUES: No additional issues were noted.
- 27 • WG5 ISSUES: No additional issues were noted.
- 28 • UIM ISSUES: No additional issues were noted.

29 The Plenary was recessed at on 3 December 2001 at 6:20 PM local time.
