1 During the period of 28-30 October 2002, 3GPP2 TSG-S meetings were held at the Sapporo Prince
2 Hotel in Sapporo, Japan. Closing Plenary was held on 4 November 2002 US time via conference call.
3 This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

4 OPENING PLENARY

5 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on
6 28 October 2002 at 8:42 AM local time by TSG-S Chair, Rich Robinson (Sprint PCS).

7 The Chair welcomed everyone to Sapporo, Japan and thanked ARIB for hosting the meeting.

8 The Chair then reviewed the meeting schedule as described in the agenda including the
9 following:

- 10 • An interim Plenary will be held on Wednesday 30 October 2002 afternoon.

12 The meeting attendees introduced themselves and their affiliation.

14 companies indicated 18 companies in attendance out of 23 active companies (78%
15 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved. A sign-in was used to document individual
