14 **Abstract:**

15 This document is a summary of the 3GPP2 TSG-S meetings that were held during the period of
16 for 8-11 December 2003 in Maui, Hawaii, USA.

1 During the period of 8-11 December 2003, 3GPP2 TSG-S meetings were held at the Grand
2 Wailea Hotel in Maui, Hawaii, USA. This document is intended to summarize those
3 proceedings.

4 OPENING PLENARY

5 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on
6 8 December 2003 at 1:25 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Richard Robinson (Sprint).

7 The Chair welcomed everyone to Maui and noted that this was the 51st meeting of
8 TSG-S. He also advised everyone of logistics details for 3GPP2 events for the week.

9 The meeting participants each introduced themselves and their affiliation. Sign-in of
10 individual participants was accomplished via the electronic sign-in facility on the LAN
11 server.

12 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of TSG-S active
13 companies indicated 16 companies in attendance out of 18 active companies (89%
14 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved.

15 3. DISTRIBUTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were
16 documented in S00-20031208-000. All contributions were distributed as soft copy and
17 were made available from the server.

18 4. ADOPTION OF AGENDA: The proposed agenda (S00-20031208-001) was presented.
19 **DECISION: The agenda was approved without objection as modified by the**
20 **discussion (S00-20031208-001R1).**

21 5. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY: The summary of
22 the October 2003 TSG-S meeting in Kobe, Japan (S00-20031208-002) was presented.
23 **DECISION: This meeting summary was approved without objection as submitted.**

24 6. REVIEW OF ACTION ITEMS FROM PREVIOUS MEETING: The following
25 contributions were left open at the last meeting and require additional consideration:

- 26 • WG3 must consider which 3GPP2 process or project document would be the
27 appropriate document to indicate the restriction on project numbers and/or
28 unresolved document references. This action is outstanding from the September
29 2003 meeting but now being considered by the WPD AdHoc. **ACTION: This**
30 **action is now closed.**
- 31 • The Secretary was requested to determine the validity of S00-20030915-014
32 correspondence from TSG-X regarding Proposed Additions to 3GPP2 Evolution
33 Document. The Secretary advised that the TSG-X Chair has confirmed the
34 referenced contribution to be invalid. **ACTION: This action is now closed.**
- 35 • The Chair was requested to solicit confirmation from the SC next week regarding
36 the appointment of TIA as the Global Hexadecimal Administrator. This item was
37 addressed at the last SC meeting. **ACTION: This action is now closed.**

- 1 • The Secretary was assigned the task to solicit the participation of Dan Bart (TIA)
2 in the 3GPP2-OMA Workshop to present on the subject of legal and copyright
3 issues that may impact this relationship. Dan Bart (TIA) has agreed to participate
4 and the OP Financial Oversight Committee has agreed to pay for his travel
5 expenses as a 3GPP2 consultant for this meeting. **ACTION: This action is now**
6 **closed.**
- 7 • The Chair indicated that he would investigate meeting room options with the
8 3GPP2 Meeting Planner to cover the additional WG time requests. **ACTION:**
9 **This action is now closed.**

10 7. CORRESPONDENCE AND LIAISON REPORTS

- 11 • SERVER AND LAN TRANSPORT: No discussion.
- 12 • 3GPP2 SC/OP: The following contributions were noted:
 - 13 • The draft meeting summary for the 3GPP2 SC meeting on 20 October
14 2003 in Kobe (S00-20031208-010) was presented from the 3GPP2
15 Secretariat. The TSG-C Secretary provided the following verbal
16 summary:
 - 17 • During the TR45 Report, the issue of ESN exhaust was discussed.
18 Girish Patel (Nortel Networks) took an action to compile a list of
19 ESN exhaust-related concerns and to offer a proposal for the
20 assignment of these concerns to TR45, the CDG and 3GPP2
21 respectively (SC ACTION 2003/10-01).
 - 22 • During the TSG-X Report:
 - 23 • TSG-X requested the SC to clarify for all TSGs the need
24 for cooperation to achieve our common objective of
25 producing high quality specifications. The TSG Chairs
26 were encouraged to use the Wednesday AM TSG
27 Leadership meeting to negotiate joint meeting schedules for
28 interim conference calls and face-to-face meetings for the
29 following month. If issues are identified after that
30 Wednesday AM meeting, TSG Chairs should be negotiated
31 among each other in advance. In addition, the Secretariat
32 will investigate a calendar management tool to better
33 document joint meetings (SC ACTION 2003/10-0?).
 - 34 • TSG-X requested modifications to the WPD to reduce the
35 meeting notice time for TSG meetings from 21 days to 7
36 days. This issue was referred to the OPs and subsequently
37 to the WPD AdHoc.

- 1 E-mail correspondence dated 3 November 2003 regarding
2 TSG-X request for WPD amendment (S00-20031208-033)
3 was presented from the WPD AdHoc. This correspondence
4 requests feedback from all TSGs regarding a TSG-X
5 proposal to modify the WPD since that the leadtime for
6 notice of TSG conference calls is reduced from 21 days to
7 7 days.
- 8 • AC Mahendran (QUALCOMM) was approved as the new
9 3GPP2 Liaison to IETF replacing Tom Hiller of Lucent
10 Technologies.
 - 11 • During the TSG-S Report, the SC recommended that TIA take on
12 the function of MEID Global Hexadecimal Administrator (GHA).
 - 13 • During the PMT Report:
 - 14 • The SC approved the updated 3GPP2 workplan.
 - 15 • Regarding the Publication Process document, the SC
16 decided that the revised publications process should be
17 implemented as soon as it is approved. However, noting
18 some urgency in the submission of documents to ITU-R
19 WP8F, HRPD Rev-A and IS-2000 Rev. D are exempt from
20 implementation of the new publications process.
 - 21 • The SC approved the content of the System Release Guide.
22 As a result, the SC SRG AdHoc was disbanded.
 - 23 • The SC Chair will request direction from the OPs regarding
24 the mechanism for approval and numbering of SC Library
25 documents.
 - 26 • Lengthy discussion were held regarding the OMA liaison
27 relationship and considerations of transfer of work to/shared work
28 with OMA. The decisions of that discussion were summarized by
29 two (2) documents prepared by Clif Barber (KDDI) as an action
30 from the SC meeting (SC ACTION 2003/10-07). Those
31 documents plus associated e-mail correspondences related to the
32 SC e-mail review of those documents are indicated in
33 S00-20031208-032. In S00-20031208-032F, the SC Chair
34 indicates that “<these> two documents should be on hold for final
35 approval but be dealt with as the working documents <and>
36 referred to as necessary for the on-going efforts concerning the
37 work relationship with OMA”.
 - 38 SC consideration on the TSG-X request to approve transfer of
39 MMS work to OMA was until the next SC meeting in February
40 2004.

1 The actions from the SC meeting relative to TSG-S were noted as follows:

30 The Plenary was reconvened on 11 December 2003 at 1:25 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Rich

31 Robinson (Sprint).

32 Quorum had been established at the opening Plenary and was not challenged at this session. No
