1 During the period of 19-23 July 2004, 3GPP2 TSG-S meetings were held at the Sheraton  
2 Universal Hotel in Los Angeles, CA, USA. This document is intended to summarize those  
3 proceedings.

#### 4 OPENING PLENARY

5 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on  
6 19 July 2004 at 1:20 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Rich Robinson (Sprint).

7 The Chair welcomed the participants to TSG-S meeting #57 and to Universal City.

8 Sign-in of individual participants was accomplished via the electronic sign-in facility on  
9 the LAN server.

10 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of TSG-S active  
11 companies indicated 14 companies in attendance out of 18 active companies (78%  
12 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved.

13 3. DISTRIBUTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were  
14 documented in S00-20040719-000. All contributions were distributed as soft copy and  
15 were made available from the server.

16 4. ADOPTION OF AGENDA: The proposed agenda (S00-20040719-001) was presented.  
17 **DECISION: The agenda was approved without objection as submitted.**

19 the June 2004 TSG-S meeting in Philadelphia, PA, USA (S00-20040719-002) was
