1 During the period of 18-21 October 2004, 3GPP2 TSG-S meetings were held at the Shanghai Bao  
2 An Hotel in Shanghai, China. This document is intended to summarize those proceedings.

### 3 OPENING PLENARY

4 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on  
5 18 October 2004 at 1:20 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Rich Robinson (Sprint). The Chair  
6 welcomed the participants to TSG-S meeting #60 and to Shanghai, China.

7 Meeting participants introduced themselves. Sign-in of individual participants was  
8 accomplished via the electronic sign-in facility on the LAN server.

9 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of TSG-S active  
10 companies indicated 14 companies in attendance out of 19 active companies (74%  
11 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved.

12 3. DISTRIBUTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were  
13 documented in S00-20041018-000. All contributions were distributed as soft copy and were  
14 made available from the server.
